







### Webinar on "Impact of COVID'19 on Digital Space












## Webinar on 'Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (POCSO) - Implementation and Judicial Approach'






### Webinar on 'Role of Police in Criminal Justice Adminstration'








### Webinar on 'Carrier Opportunities in Law'









### Webinar on 'Understanding the basics of Research'








### Webinar on 'the Art of Advocacy and Drafting'.





## Webinar on 'Demystify the role of forensic science in the justice delivery system'



### Webinar on 'Cyber Law in Covid Era'.


