Report of Placement Cell Recruitment Drive 2021-22

1. Placement Cell of 2021-22 planned a recruitment drive and contacted a number of firms that earlier recruited our students with whom the cell established a good communication through the coordinators.
2. However, the cell did not receive a positive responses from the employers. Some of the reasons to such responses were time constraint and on campus recruitment. The firms that were contacted are mentioned below:
 - a) **AAA Insolvency, Navi Mumbai:** Contacted for the recruitment drive, currently they do not have any vacancy for the post of an associate and are not in need of law graduates/final year law students.
 - b) **Adv. Rachana Agrawal, Sion:** The advocate was also contacted for recruitment drive. Multiple calls were made but she was not answering the calls and hence was unreachable.
 - c) **HNT Legal:** The firm was contacted however, the cell got no response as the employer did not receive the calls.
 - d) **Lloyd & Johnson:** Adv. Biju Johnson was contacted by the cell. He was interested in recruiting students earlier, however, his firm needed expertise on admiralty/maritime laws and thus the offer was turned down.

➤ Way forward:

- The drive should be planned in the first half of the cell formation.
- A layout should be prepared by the cell in coordination with all the members, coordinators, heads, and faculties' in-charge.
- The drive should be presented to the college and the college should pitch in for the recruitment since it is the beginning of V.E.S Placement Cell and so it creates a better impact on the recruiter.
- The training and workshops given to the students by the cell are to be presented to the employers.
- The advocates attending the events of the college shall be pitched in to recruit a number of students in the final year.
- The execution of placement drive shall begin in the second half of the year.

V. PROCEDURE ESTABLISHED BY THE CELL FOR ITS FUNCTIONING

1. In the first half, a form was circulated for the students of the college to fill in and get updates and opportunities through the cell. With a promising response of 160 plus students from all classes, a system was implemented where according to the interest mentioned by students and other eligibility criteria, they were given a call if an opportunity in that respect came in. Their CV would then be checked and changes would be suggested if any. The candidates would then be asked to mail their CVs to the employer.
2. This worked fairly well in the first half and , in the second half a fresh form was issued for the same purpose , it garnered 120 plus responses. However, the responses started getting less interaction from students. So, the cell changed its pattern and implemented a completely new response which yielded fairly great results.
3. The new system was that all opportunities of all departments were circulated in all classes and students were asked to approach the cell as per their wants. A telegram group for the same was also formed, which has around 150 members.
4. SOPs were also circulated to the coordinators and members by heads to ensure smooth working of the cell.
5. Grievance Resolution Mechanism: The cell followed the hierarchical grievance mechanism.
The members approached their respective coordinators, coordinators approached the heads and the heads reached out to faculties in case of any dispute/issues arising out of the cell.
It was also mentioned that in case of emergency, the hierarchical ladder could be skipped but the heads should be informed of the same.
6. Regular Follow ups: The cell took follow up of the students placed by it after completing a month at the internship to know of their experience in the internship. We have received some promising responses from the students who were placed by us.

VI. STRUCTURAL CHANGES

- Few members have left the cell due to personal commitments and family issues.
- Coordinator Ashish Gautam (TYBLS) left his position and the cell.
- 3 new members were introduced in the cell in the second half.
