4. **ADMINISTRATOR**



**RESPONSIBILITIES AND FUNCTIONS WHICH ACCOMPANY  
EACH POSITION:-**

**• GENERAL SECRETARY**

- I. The General Secretary's (GS) position is the highest (student) position that an individual student can attain but with great power comes great responsibility the GS would be considered as the captain of the ship charged with the responsibility of all actions and endeavours undertaken by the Students Council around the year.
- II. The General secretary would be the primary link of communication between the faculty and students diaspora.
- III. He would be the acting voice of the entire Student Fraternity and would be responsible for taking various steps and decisions for the Student-welfare as well as work towards the coercive growth and development of student fraternity as a unified soul.
- IV. The General Secretary would be considered as the foremost student representative charged with the responsibility of successfully organising and planning various academic, cultural and sports events throughout the academic year.
- V. The General secretary would be the individual charged with the highest level of responsibility and would be directly held responsible for success as well as the failures that the Student council stumbles in the course of its various endeavours that it undertakes around the academic year.



• **JOINT-SECRETARY**

- VI. The Job Description or Designation of the JOINT SECRETARY is very similar to that of the GENERAL SECRETARY
- VII. The position of the Joint Secretary assumes the same level of importance as that of the GS.
- VIII. Together with the GS the Joint secretary shares equal responsibility in all actions and endeavours that the Student council undertakes with a view on students welfare.
- IX. The Joint Secretary would assume the same amount of power and responsibility in managing and supervising various college affairs from organising various events to working towards the welfare of the student fraternity.

• **TREASURER**

- X. The third and another important pillar of the core committee is the TREASURER who would be responsible for managing and maintaining the financial health of the students council as well as ensuring maintenance of complete financial records of various events organised by the Council through the Academic Year.
- XI. The Treasurer would also be charged with the responsibility of organising and raising funds throughout the academic year by way of sponsorships in collaboration with the PR & Sponsorship Head who would be appointed in course of the academic year.
- XII. The Treasurer would also be the sole link between the faculty and the students diaspora as far as financial matters or matters related to budget allocation are concerned.



**XIII. It would be the Treasurer's Prerogative to chalk out and finalise the budget allocation for various events that the Student Council organises during the academic year and also to mobilise the funds required for the same in collaboration with the treasurer or heads of the respective committee organising the said event.**

**• ADMINISTRATOR**

**XIV. The last and most important pillar of the core committee is the position of the ADMINISTRATOR.**

**XV. The Administrator would be responsible for maintaining complete records of various committee meetings undertaken by various committees of the student council and would act as a disciplinary Authority overseeing the functioning and working of various committees of the student council.**

**XVI. The Administrator would be the authority charged with the responsibility of maintaining complete discipline among the student body and would be empowered to take strict disciplinary action against any committee member or student at large who is found guilty of misconduct or untowardly behaviour in connivance of the faculty concerned.**

**XVII. And the last function of the Administrator would be to draft/prepare a comprehensive Report giving a brief overview of each and every event (Academic/Sports/Cultural) that the College organises in collaboration with the committee members of the concerned committees.**
