








REPORT- ADVOCACY SKILLS COMPETITION


REPORT: INTRA - COLLEGIATE DEBATE COMPETITION HELD ON 24TH SEPTEMBER,2019.







VIVEKANAND EDUCATION SOCIETY'S COLLEGE OF LAW CULTURAL COMMITTEE LAKSHYA,2021-2022
