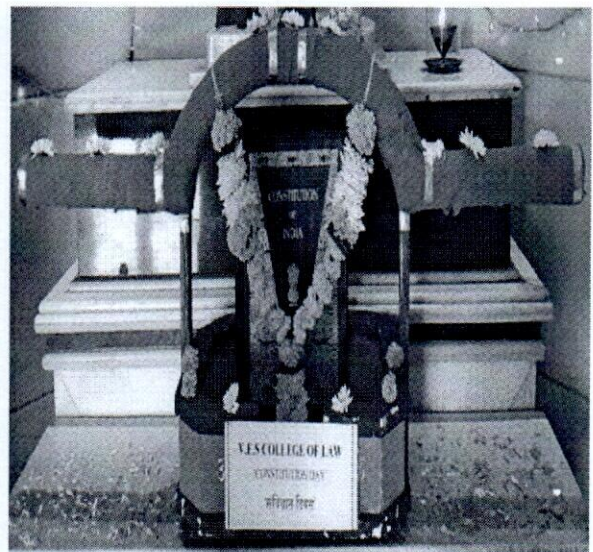

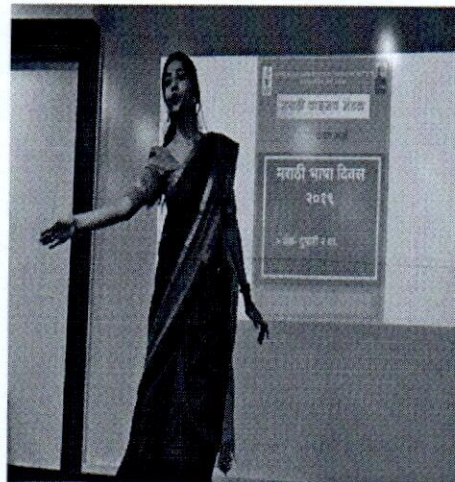

CELEBRATED ON 28TH FEBRUARY, 2020.

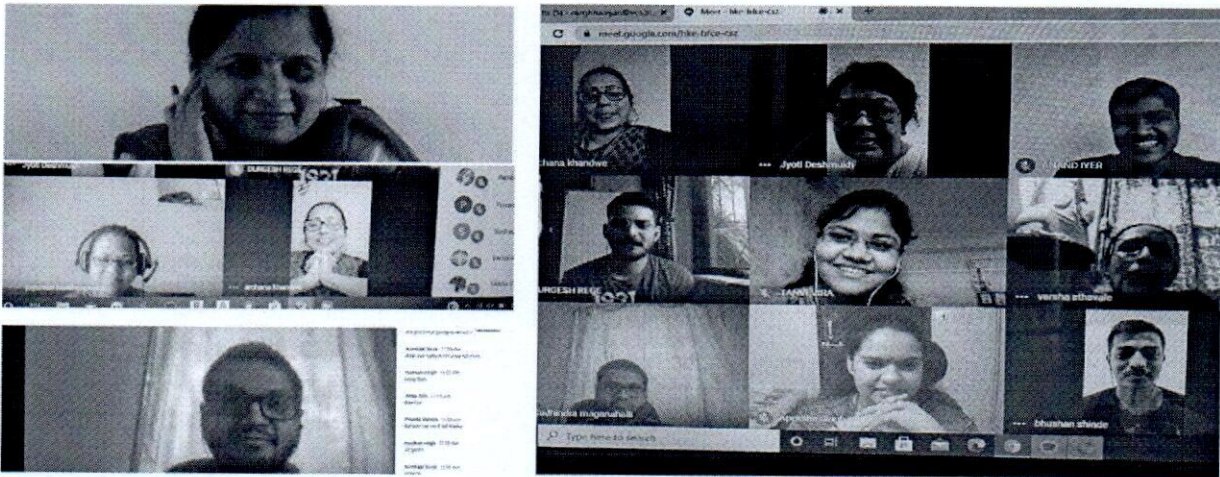
