Online LL.M. Common Entrance Test Guidelines for Admission to LL.M. Programme – 2023-2024

The Department of Law, University of Mumbai is conducting Online LL.M. Common Entrance Exam for admission of LL.M. (Two Years) Programme for the academic year 2023-2024.

Eligibility: Candidates who have passed LL.B._or those who have appeared for the <u>Final Semester Examinations of 3 or 5 year LL.B. Programme</u> from the University of Mumbai or any other recognized University are eligible to apply for online LL.M. Common Entrance Examination 2023.

Candidates who are currently pursuing LL.M. will be required to cancel their earlier LL.M. Admission for appearing in LL.M. CET 2023.

Application for Online LL.M. Entrance Examination should be made in the prescribed form which is available on the following website:

ADMISSION TO LL.M TWO YEAR PROGRAMME SHALL BE MADE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MERIT LIST OF THE LL.M. ENTRANCE EXAMINATION 2023, RESERVATION POLICY OF THE GOVERNMENT OF MAHARASHTRA AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MUMBAI.

Candidates are required to secure at least Minimum Qualifying Marks in the LL.M. Entrance Examination as under:

40 Marks - For General Category and 30 Marks - For Reserved Category

The LL.M. Entrance Examination Test paper will consist of 50 Objective type questions (multiple choice) for a total of 100 marks. There shall be no negative marking for wrong answers.

- 1. ALONGWITH THE APPLICATION FORM, CANDIDATES BELONGING TO RESERVED CATEGORIES SHOULD UPLOAD CASTE CERTIFICATE ISSUED BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY OF GOVERNMENT OF MAHARASHTRA.
- CANDIDATES BELONGING TO OBC, SBC, VJ/DT, NT(A), NT(B), NT(C), NT(D)CATEGORIES SHOULD SUBMIT A VALID NON CREAMY LAYER CERTIFICATE OR COPY OF THE RECEIPT OF APPLICATION FOR NON-CREAMY LAYER CERTIFICATE.
- 3. CANDIDATES APPLYING FOR QUOTAS [DIVYANG (DIFFERENTLY ABLED), FREEDOM FIGHTER, ORPHAN, WIDOW, EX-SERVICEMAN, SPORTS, CULTURAL ACTIVITY ETC.] SHOULD SUBMIT THEIR RESPECTIVE CERTIFICATES ISSUED BY COMPETENT AUTHORITY WHEREVER APPLICABLE.
- 4. CANDIDATES BELONGING TO ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTIONS SHOULD SUBMIT A COPY OF ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTIONS ISSUED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF MAHARASHTRA.

After the declaration of result of online LL.M. CET Exam, Candidates are required to apply according to their preferences i.e. (to Department of Law / Law Colleges), where they wish to take admission.

- 2. IN THE EVENT OF EQUAL MARKS SECURED BY THE CANDIDATES IN THE LL.M. CET, INTER-SE MERIT WILL BE DECIDED AS PER MARKS SECURED IN THE LL.B. EXAMINATION AND IN THE EVENT OF EQUAL MARKS SECURED BY THE CANDIDATES IN THE LL.B. EXAMINATION TOO, INTER-SE MERIT WILL BE DECIDED AS PER THE MARKS SECURED IN HSC OR EQUIVALENT EXAMINATION.

- 3. DURING THE EXAMINATION, ALL ACTIVITIES OF CANDIDATE'S DEVICE SHALL BE STRICTLY MONITORED THROUGH VIDEO AND HUMAN PROCTORING. CANDIDATES ARE STRICTLY INFORMED TO KEEP THEIR CAMERA 'ON' DURING THE DURATION OF THE EXAM.

- 6. DIVYANG (DIFFERENTLY ABLED) CANDIDATES WILL BE PROVIDED EXTRA TIME OF 20 MINUTES FOR THE EXAMINATION AS PER THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MUMBAI.
- 7. THE RESULT OF THIS ONLINE LL.M. CET 2023 WILL BE VALID FOR THIS ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-2024 ONLY.
- 8. AFTER THE ONLINE LL.M. CET EXAMINATION, THE ADMISSIONS TO THE LL.M. PROGRAME SHALL NOT BE CENTRALISED. THE CANDIDATES SHALL BE REQUIRED TO CONTACT EACH INSTITUTION (DEPARTMENT OF LAW/ LAW COLLEGE) INDEPENDENTLY FOR ADMISSION TO THE INSTITUTION.
