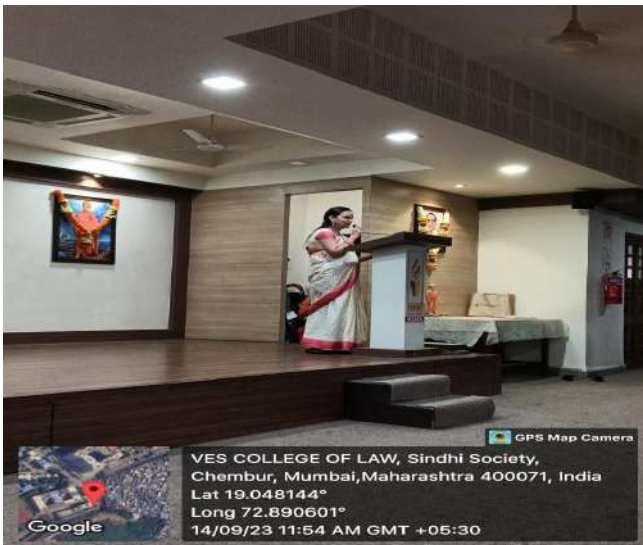



This session may include a discussion on legal fees and shall entail the advocates assisting the client to enable him to make an informed choice about the legal recourse available for him for addressing his concern.

Exploration of Dispute Resolution:

He underscored the pivotal role of cybersecurity as a crucial tool in combating these threats. He noted that as transactions and activities in the digital sphere become more advanced, the legislative framework has struggled to keep pace, leaving certain forms of cybercrime inadequately addressed.
