Through this competition, a law student can understand and experience the intricacies of an attorney-client relationship.



NATURE OF THE COMPETITION

1.The competition shall simulate a client's first interview at law office/chamber.

2.The intake capacity of the competition is 16 teams only on the first-cum-first erved basis. The registration would close thereafter. The registrations shall be online. No offline registrations shall be entertained.

This session may include a discussion on legal fees and shall entail the advocates assisting the client to enable him to make an informed choice about the legal recourse available for him for addressing his concern.

- Conduct and Behavior: Maintain respect and discipline. Indiscipline can lead to penalties or disqualification.

Library tutorial for 2023-24 was conducted to familiarize first year students with the library's resources and services. It included


- Library Resources: Introduction to print books, journals, and electronic resources like legal databases (SCConline).

- Resource Access: Instructions on accessing both print materials and digital resources through the library's website and e-resource center.


Details of the Library Tutorial

- Feedback Mechanism: Collected feedback from students to continuously improve the tutorial sessions.














