It is one of the most enthralling events hosted at our prestigious institute. The objective is to imbibe mooting and debating skills in law students; cause them to become familiar with the formal procedure of the courts; and set them up on their journey to

## 1. Short Title:

This competition shall be referred to as the "7th Edition Intra Collegiate Moot Court Competition, 2023" held by the Vivekanand Education Society's College of Law.

## 2. Definitions:

In the context herein:

- i."Appellant" includes Appellant, Plaintiff, Petitioner, Complainant, Prosecution, Informant, etc.
- ii."Bench" pertains to the individuals invited to judge the oral rounds, either individually or as a panel.
- iii."Clarifications" refer to explanations provided by the Host University regarding queries from participating teams within the stipulated deadline.
- iv."Competition" denotes the Intra Moot Court Competition.
- v."Moot Proposition" signifies the problem released by the Organizers on the specified date in Rule II (2), including subsequent clarifications.
- vi."Oral Score" denotes the scores awarded by judges to a particular speaker from a participating team during oral assessments.

vii."Organizers" signifies Vivekanand Education Society's College of Law, General Secretary, Core Committee and Moot Court Association Head.

viii."Participating Team" refers to teams eligible for participation in the Competition after completing the registration procedure.

ix."Respondent" includes Defendant, Respondent, Defence, etc.

x."Rules" are the rules governing the Intra Moot Court Competition.

xi."Team Code" is a unique code assigned by the Association to the registered participating team.

xii."Written Submissions" signifies the memorandum of written submissions (memorials) submitted by any participating team according to the Competition rules.

## 3. Date and Venue of the Competition:

The Intra Moot Court Competition will take place on 28th Day of October, 2023 at the Vivekanand Education Society's College of Law. The mode of the Competition will be offline.

# 4. Team Eligibility and Composition:

Participation is limited to bona fide law students pursuing the

V.E.S. College of Law Sindhi Society, Cheshour, Mumbai participating team must consist of three members, with two designated as 'Mooter' and one as 'Researcher.'

# 5. Registration Procedure:

Registration for the moot will commence on 9th October, 2023 at 1:00 PM near the Office Wing Stilt Area. A total of 16 slots are available on a first-come-first-served basis.

Teams backing out will be barred from the further competitions conducted by the Moot Court Association.

## 6. Written Submissions:

Written Submissions should adhere to specific guidelines regarding formatting and should contain inter alia the following.

## **6.1 Written Submissions Structure:**

The Written Submissions must contain the following contents:

- Cover Page The cover page shall contain the case title, side of the written submission, year of Competition, name of the forum, and team Code in the top right corner;
- Table of Contents
- Index of Authorities The Index of Authorities must list all the authorities cited in the Written Submission. The Index must indicate the page number(s) and/or the paragraph number(s) of the

- Statement of Jurisdiction

- Prayer

# **6.2 Guidelines for Formatting:**


- Font, size, and line spacing: The text font should be Times New Roman, size 12, and must be in 1.5 line spacing.
- Footnotes: The footnotes must be in font Times New Roman, size 10, and singly spaced. The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation (20th Edition) should be followed in the written submission throughout.
- Header and Footer: The font used for the header/footer, if any, shall be Times New Roman, size 10, and 1 spacing.
- Page Limit: The maximum page limit on the Written Submissions is 25 pages. No annexures, photographs, exhibits, etc. should be added to the written submission.
- Binding of Written Submission: Since the college follows the principles of SDG, it encourages eco-friendly practices, hence, it is recommended that the teams bind their written submission with

V.E.S. Colloge of Law Sindhi Society, Chembur, Mumbai • eco-friendly method of binding.

## **6.3 Memorial Submission:**

- All memorials submitted for all purposes of the Competition shall firmly comply with the rules of the Competition. Each participating team must prepare two written submissions, one for each Petitioner/Applicant(s) as well as Respondent(s) side.
- Petitioner/Applicant(s) memorials are required to have a Blue Cover and Respondent(s) memorials are required to have Red Cover.
- Teams have to prepare Written Submissions for both the sides in the Competition. Memorial submissions are to be made before 11:59:59 PM on 25th of October, 2023 in the format of soft copies of memorials shall be submitted in either .pdf or .doc/.docx via google link that will be notified accordingly and 4 hard copies shall be submitted by 2:00:00 PM on 26th of October, 2023.

Non-compliance will result in penalties and shall attract deduction of ½ mark on each contravention. Late submission than the given deadline shall attract deduction of 1 mark each per hour. After 12 hours, the memorial shall not be considered for submission. The OC will not be responsible for any delay of default.



# 7. Oral Pleadings:

There will be a total of **4 rounds** of the Competition. The rounds will be Preliminary Round (Round 1 & 2), Semi Finals and Final Round.

# Preliminary Rounds

Each team will get a total of 15 minutes to present their case. This time will include rebuttal and sur-rebuttal time [if permitted by the judge(s)]. The time distribution per speaker is left at the discretion of the teams subject to a minimum of 6 minutes per speaker and no more than 8 minutes per speaker. Rebuttals can be allocated a time of a maximum of 2 minutes. In Preliminary Round 2 all the teams will switch their sides and argue.

The Draw of Lots for this round will be held in due course of time. Top 4 teams i.e. 1 team from each **COURT ROOMS** will qualify for the Semi -Final Rounds.

# Semi-Finals

Each team will get a total of 20 minutes to present their case. This time will include rebuttal and sur-rebuttal time [if permitted by the judge(s)]. The time distribution per speaker is left at the discretion of the teams subject to a minimum of 8 minutes per speaker and not more than 10 minutes per speaker. Rebuttals can be allocated a time of a maximum of 2 minutes.

Top 2 teams will qualify for the Final Round

# Finals

Each team will get a total of 30 minutes to present their case. This time will include rebuttal and sur-rebuttal time [if permitted by the judge(s)]. The time distribution per speaker is left at the discretion of the teams subject to a minimum of 10 minutes per speaker and not more than 15 minutes per speaker. Rebuttals can be allocated a time of a maximum of 3 minutes.

During each of the abovementioned rounds, the order in which the teams shall present their arguments is as follows:

- Appellant/Petitioner Speaker 1;
- Appellant/Petitioner Speaker 2;
- Respondent Speaker 1;
- Respondent Speaker 2;
- Rebuttal: Appellant Any one of the two Speakers;
- Sur-rebuttal: Respondent Any one of the two Speakers.

(Rebuttals shall be permitted only at the discretion of the Bench.) The use of mobile phones, laptops, or any other electronic gadgets is strictly prohibited during the Oral Rounds, subject to the discretion of the judges.

# 8. Judging Criteria:

Award of the points shall be based on the following parameters:

- Memorial/Written Submissions
- 1. Depth and quality of research
- 2. Knowledge and application of facts



- 4. Referencing
- 5. Presentation

## Oral Rounds

- 1. Interpretation and application of laws and facts
- 2. Style, Poise, Courtesy and Demeanour
- 3. Ingenuity and ability to answer question
- 4. Organization and flow of arguments
- 5. Reference to memorial in the course of argument

## 9. Researchers' Test:

There shall be a Multiple Choice Questionnaire and Descriptive based test for designated researchers from each team wherein 20 MCQ questions shall be asked and 2 descriptive questions will be asked.

The subject matter of the researchers' test is pari materia to subject matter of moot proposition.

## 10. General Etiquette:

Participants are expected to behave dignifiedly and not to cause any inconvenience to the Organizers, the Judges of the Competition, or any of the other participants. The Organisers reserve the right to take appropriate action for any unethical, unprofessional, or immoral conduct.

# 11. Interpretation of Rules and Regulations:

All interpretations, as well as any waivers, consents, or other decisions in the administration of the Competition, are at the complete discretion of the Organizers. Any decision made by the Organizers shall be final and binding on all participating teams. If a team is of the perspective that violation of the rules of the competition has taken place at any stage of the competition, the team (s) shall inform within half an hour after the completion of the round to the Organizing Committee.

Team(s) under no circumstances shall approach the judges with any complaints.

# 12. Anonymity of Teams:

Teams shall not reveal their identity in any form, except by means of the Team Code allotted to them during the Competition.

The Written Submission shall not reveal the identity of the team in any form.

Any violation of the above rules shall attract severe penalty or disqualification as determined by the organizing committee. The decision of the organizing committee in this regard shall be final and binding on the participating team.

#### **REPORT**

#### 7th Intra-Collegiate Moot Court Competition, 2023

The 7th Intra-Collegiate Moot Court Competition was organised by the Moot Court Association of VES College of Law on the 28th of October, 2023. The main objective of this competition is to inculcate mooting culture amongst the students and to prepare them for national and international level competitions. Further, the aim is to imbibe mooting and debating skills in law students; cause them to become familiar with the formal procedure of the courts; and set them up on their journey to seek justice.

A brochure along with the moot propsition and formal message had been circulated by the Moot Court Association to all the students on the 9th of October, 2023 via Official Whatsapp Groups.

The brochure contained all the details and information related to the competition like rules and regulations, registration dates, structure and nature of competition, written submissions and oral rounds, etc.

The registration for the competition was to be held offline. The registration desk for the same was set up in the college campus on the same day itself, 9th October 2023 at 01:00 pm. The registrations were to be on a first-come-first-served basis.

The registration cap for the competition was initially 16 teams, however having received an overwhelming response, the Moot Court Association increased it to 24 teams.

However in due course of time, 6 teams from the cap of 24 backed off, thereby taking the final cap to 18 Teams.
