6.1.2 The effective leadership is visible in various institutional practices such as decentralization and participative management.

Response:

The College emphasizes on practice of participative management and decentralization as part of the functioning of all activities. Different student committees are performing to the fullest capacity because of decentralization. The faculty coordinators for various committees ensure flexibility to design and arrange activities based on inputs from stakeholders.

National Law Fest is the epitome of participative management and decentralization. Till 2022-23 the college was arranging National Level Moot court competition.

In 2023-24 the college went one step ahead and arranged number of events like National level Moot Court competition, National Debate and Public Interest Litigation (PIL) drafting Competition, National level Client Counselling competition, under National Law Festival themed around Artificial Intelligence, from 12th to 14th January 2024. The aim was to imbibe mootting, dealing with clients, drafting PIL and debating skills in law students.

The competition had an active participation from the student-driven committees headed by student coordinators consisting of various other committees. The faculty coordinators oversee the overall organization of the Festival. The decision-making process was top to bottom and bottom to top, where all the members of this institution participated in the process. The selection of the Secretary and other members is through applications and interviews. The applications are screened by selection committee composed of faculty in charge and other core members. Heads and members are selected by the committee on the basis of interview judging the capacity and potentiality of each applicant for the post they have applied for. The newly selected core heads decide by consensus the departments to be headed by each of them.

Once the committees are formed, the theme is finalized in the meeting comprising the Principal and faculties. Once finalized, the members finalize the events in the meetings. Tentative schedule is prepared and shared with all. The roles assigned to students are diverse and require interpersonal skills. Topics for debate, PIL drafting and for client counselling and two moot problems were circulated to various law colleges all over India through emails and hard copies of the brochure. One problem was allotted for preliminary round and second problem was for

the semi-final and final rounds as decided in meeting with faculties and Students' Council Members.

Regular meetings were held in October and November for finalizing dates of registration and other required procedures. In the first week of January the flow of event was decided by faculties in meetings.

For the event 5 classrooms were engaged for preliminary round of moot court. 2 classrooms were engaged for preliminary round of debate and 3 classrooms were engaged for client counselling and e-resource center was engaged for preliminary round of PIL drafting competition. Heads of Moot court association, debate committee shouldered the responsibility for arrangements under guidance of In-charge teachers. Three student volunteers accompanied the participants in the event from the competition rooms to rooms allotted. Heads of the competition and in-charge faculties shouldered the responsibility for arrangements in auditorium and board room.

On all three days various committees like food committee, logistic committee, felicitation committee, escort committee, certificate committee along with their in charge teachers and volunteers managed the event successfully.

Our principal, teachers and alumni members arranged the guests for judging the competitions which include senior advocates and sitting/retired judges of Bombay High Court. Our alumni members were also invited to judge preliminary and semi-final rounds of the competitions depending on their seniority.

Overall the organization is an excellent example of participative management and decentralized decision making, empowering our students, faculty members and administrative staff with various skills. Anchored by the mentorship, students exercise their due diligence, authority and learn to take decisions. Thus, the events and especially National Law Fest is the example for students' and teachers' collaborative management in achieving the goals by mutual planning done by following democratic standards.

REPORT

1ST NATIONAL LAW FEST, 2023-2024

The VES College of Law hosted its inaugural National Law Fest, themed around Artificial Intelligence, from January 12th to 14th, 2024. The event drew participation from over 43 colleges across India, competing in various events such as National Moot Court Competition, National Client Counselling, National Debate, and Public Interest Litigation (PIL) Drafting. More than 20 esteemed dignitaries attended as judges and chief guests, contributing to the fest's success. This grand three-day event marked a significant milestone in VES College of Law's engagement with the evolving intersection of AI and the legal field.

The 6th Shri Hashuji Advani Memorial National Moot Court Competition, 2023-24 was organised by the VES College of Law from the 12th of January to the 14th of January, 2023. The main objective of this competition was to inculcate and fuse the culture of legal competitions amongst the students. Further, the aim was to imbibe mootng, dealing with clients, drafting PILs and debating skills in law students; cause them to become familiar with the formal procedure of the courts and the know-how of other methods such as that of ADR; and set them up on their journey to seek and grant justice.

MOOT COURT COMPETITION

A brochure along with the moot proposition and formal message had been circulated by the Moot Court Association's official e-mail to all the colleges across the country on the 12th of November, 2023. The brochure contained all the details and information related to the competition like rules and regulations, registration dates, structure and nature of competition, written submissions and oral rounds, etc. The registration for the competition was through a google form with a minimal fee of ₹3000/- per team along with 1000 for each member for accommodation (provided the first come first served and the availability criteria). The registrations were to be on a first-come-first-served basis. However, provisional registrations were given special consideration. The registration cap for the competition was initially 24 teams, however due to different unfavourable circumstances, the registrations were 20 out of which 2 teams backed out just before the submission of the soft copy of the memorial.

Following the process of registration, a message regarding Call for Volunteers was also circulated. The College invited students to become volunteers and fuel the spirit of the competition. Post this, a list was prepared, for both participants of the competition as well as the volunteers. A separate WhatsApp Group was formed for both the members and volunteers so as to update with all the official information for the participants and meeting updates that will follow for the volunteers.
