In continuation to "Campus to Corporate", VESLARC recently conducted a half-day workshop, with demo sessions, for Personal Interviews. Many students of VES College of Pharmacy participated in this activity.

The session was aimed towards students planning their admission into MBA programmes, as well as considering employment, since the interview process at MBA institutes for 2018 is beginning from February.

Some of the discussed themes were:

1. Pre-interview preparation - the importance of homework
2. What the institute/ organisation looks for - hence working backward from there, what one should work on
3. Commonly asked questions in interviews - students had been previously given questions whose answers they wrote and brought to the workshop, for discussion
4. Errors to avoid in terms of answers and attitudes
5. At the venue - tips and techniques to deal with stress
6. Linkage of course / subjects studied, and interview preparation
7. Handling stress interviews and challenging questions

The highly interactive session, included one-to-one interaction as well as mock interviews.
