Event Summary

Swami Vivekananda (1863-1902 C.E.) was a Hindu monk and a patriotic saint of India. According to English calendar he was born on 12th January 1863 into an aristocratic Bengali family of Calcutta. Indian government has decided to observe Swami Vivekananda's Gregorian date of birth as National Youth Day. Hence National Youth Day of India is celebrated each year on 12th January since 1985.

As one of the established and recognized institute across Mumbai, we at V.E.S.Polytechnic also celebrate National Youth Day as Traditional Day with an intention to spread the message of Swami Vivekananda. Thus on January 12, 2018 we celebrated Traditional Day.

The event started with enlightening of lamp by our Principal Mr. Vikrant Joshi, PRO, Sir J. J. Mahanagar Raktapedhi, Mr. Ajay Bhise and Event Incharge, Mrs. Vaishali.Bodhale as a tribute to Maa Saraswati, the Goddess of knowledge.
