

## **Minutes of BOS Physics Meeting**

The first BoS meeting was held online on 18th December 2021 at 11 AM.

In the meeting, following the welcome address by Dr. Anita Kanwar, the syllabus for F.Y. B.Sc. for SEM 1 and 2 was approved. Framework of syllabus of SY and TY is also discussed and approved. It was also decided that the exam pattern for theory papers would be of 25 marks internal and 75 marks external evaluation. Different schemes of internal evaluations were deliberated and it was approved that various evaluation strategies such as tests, assignments as well as different activities may be used. In 75 marks external, question paper patterns were

discussed and approved. Question paper setting, moderation and evaluation will be carried out by internal teachers. Furthermore, a pattern of evaluation of practical was approved. F.Y.B.Sc and S.Y. B.Sc. practical would be evaluated by internal examiners as decided in the meeting. For T.Y.B.Sc. practical exam, it was approved that one external examiner associated with UG colleges affiliated to Mumbai University or research institutes or PG Alumni will be invited for conduct of exam/viva. However, in case of non-availability of external examiners during exams, the exam will be carried out by internal examiners. Further, different methodologies for innovative teaching and evaluation techniques were deliberated and approved that as per need of the subject/concept requirement different tools will be used. Meeting was concluded with a vote of thanks by chairperson Dr. Anita Kanwar.
