1) **Agenda No.1** - To approve the new programmes of study leading to degrees and/or diplomas and certificate courses as approved by the Academic Council.

Principal Dr. Anita Kanwar presented the following courses which were previously approved in the meeting with the Academic Council members.

- f) PG Diploma in Medical Lab Technology (Intake:35)

Further all the certificate courses (20 in number) were also enlisted by Principal in her presentation in addition to certificate courses available on Swayam, NPTEL etc. The Governing Body members unanimously approved all the above courses and the minutes of Academic council meeting. The minutes of the Academic council meeting was shared with all Governing Body members in this regard.

2) Agenda No.2 To approve the Fee structure (2022-23), annual budget (2022-23), of the college as finalized in the finance committee meeting.

Principal Dr. Anita Kanwar presented the details of Fees structure and the annual budget for the academic year 2022-23 which were previously approved in the meeting with the Finance committee members. The minutes of the Finance Committee meeting was shared with all Governing Body members in this regard. The Governing Body members unanimously approved the fee structure and the annual budget for 2022-23. Principal Dr. Anita Kanwar informed about the number of additional posts sanctioned for SFC and Autonomous courses in the academic year 2022-23 and informed the members that the college Management has already given permission to advertise for the recruitments to be made for both Teaching and Non Teaching staff and the work in this regard is in progress. The Governing Body members appreciated the initiatives of the VES Management and have asked for the updates on action taken in this regard in the following meeting.
