Meeting Conducted as follows

1. The BOS Meeting started with the Welcome Address to all BOS members by the Chairperson Mr. Gokul Choudhary
2. Mr. Gokul Choudhary welcomed and gave a brief introduction of Vice Chancellor nominee Dr.Swati Vitkar and also new faculty member of DSDA Mrs. Padmaja Purnandare was introduced to the BOS members.
3. The following Agendas were discussed in the BOS meeting for AY -2024-25

Agenda 1 - To discuss and sanction the FYDSDA(NEP), SYDSDA (NEP) and TYDSDA (Non-NEP) syllabi for the academic year 2024-25

Following discussion were made to approve the Syllabus -

- A. Mr. Gokul Choudhary thanked the teachers of our college who helped in designing the syllabus of DSDA syllabus
- B. Mr. Gokul Choudhary syllabus structure of FYDSDA with following minor changes
 - a. Title of MINOR subject of maths “Mathematical Methods for Artificial Intelligence “. We have added some new topics in FYDSDA syllabus as per the title and importance of topics in minor as Artificial Intelligence.
 - b. Some additional subjects might be added in OE basket as the college is starting some new courses from next academic year.
 - c. New IQAC guidelines were passed by IQAC Regarding the CC credits and CC hours . the following policy we are following for marking in CC course
 - d. grading system and CC marking system was discussed
- C. Mr. Gokul Choudhary syllabus structure of SYDSDA with following minor changes
 - a. Major and minor syllabus discussion with titles. As per the MH govt circular dated 20th April 2023 एनईपी-2022/प्र.सं.09/विशि-3/शिकाना we will be having following credit allocations in sem 3 and sem4.
 - b. Major - 6 - 8 credit - we are adopting 8 credit major so we will be having 3 theory subjects of 2 credits and 2 credit practical’s of two major subjects combined like fy.
 - c. Minor is having 4 credits in each semester - we are taking Artificial Intelligence as minor so it will be approx. 18 to 20 credits throughout the UG degree. Minor 4 credit courses will be divided in 2-2 credit of theory and Practical component.
 - d. AEC - 4 credit (2 Credit Each Sem) for Ability Enhancement course it has been decided that there will be common basket of Indian origin Languages at college level approved by IQAC and NEP Committee as per the recommendations following languages will be there in common basket of Indian origin Languages - Hindi, Sindhi, Sanskrit and Marathi
 - e. OPEN ELECTIVE: Will be allocated to the students based on their Sem 1 totals . subjects can be taken from the common baskets
- D. Prof GC explained syllabus structure of TYDSDA with following minor changes
 - a. Project development and Project dissertation will be there in both the semesters.

- b. 20 Hrs. Data Visualization using tableau training sessions is compulsory for students to attend.
 - c. Research Paper writing in semester 6 project dissertation
- E. At end of FYDSDA, SYDSDA and TYDSDA syllabus presentation, by coordinator and subject teacher, before the BOS members and it is passed and accepted by all BOS members with following minor suggestions.

Following minor suggestions were given by the external members of BOS –

a. Dr.Swati Vitkar ,SIES College, Nerul

- Madam suggested that the research paper writing inclusion in Sem 6th is a good idea and let them participate in various conferences and research activities in different other colleges.
- Madam also suggested that research paper writing should be encouraged to students from 2nd year itself.

b. Dr. Manoj Devare, School of Information Technology, Amity University, Mumbai

- Sir suggested project should be research-based project publication.
- Entire research paper project process should be carried out in different phases like proposal preparation, define research objective, problem statements literature reviews of the existing papers and to publish the research paper.

c. Mr. Kamalakar Bhopatkar, HOD - CS Department, VESASC

- Sir suggested that VSC courses can be implemented as practical paper in consultation with principal madam and higher authority

d. Mr. Smitraj Raut, Subject Expert (R&D/ Industry/Alumni):

- Sir suggested that the research work should be continuous work spanning 4 semesters in which we can decide for topic and prework the topic along with its documentation and then implement the same in next year.

Agenda 2 - Implementation of NEP for 2024-25 - CC,CEP,FP,OE,MINOR

- Major and minor syllabus discussion with titles. As per the **Maharashtra government circular: एनईपी-2022/प्र.सं.09/विशि-3/शिकाना** dated 20th April 2023 .
- We have framed the syllabus based on above mentioned circulars which we all have agreed to.

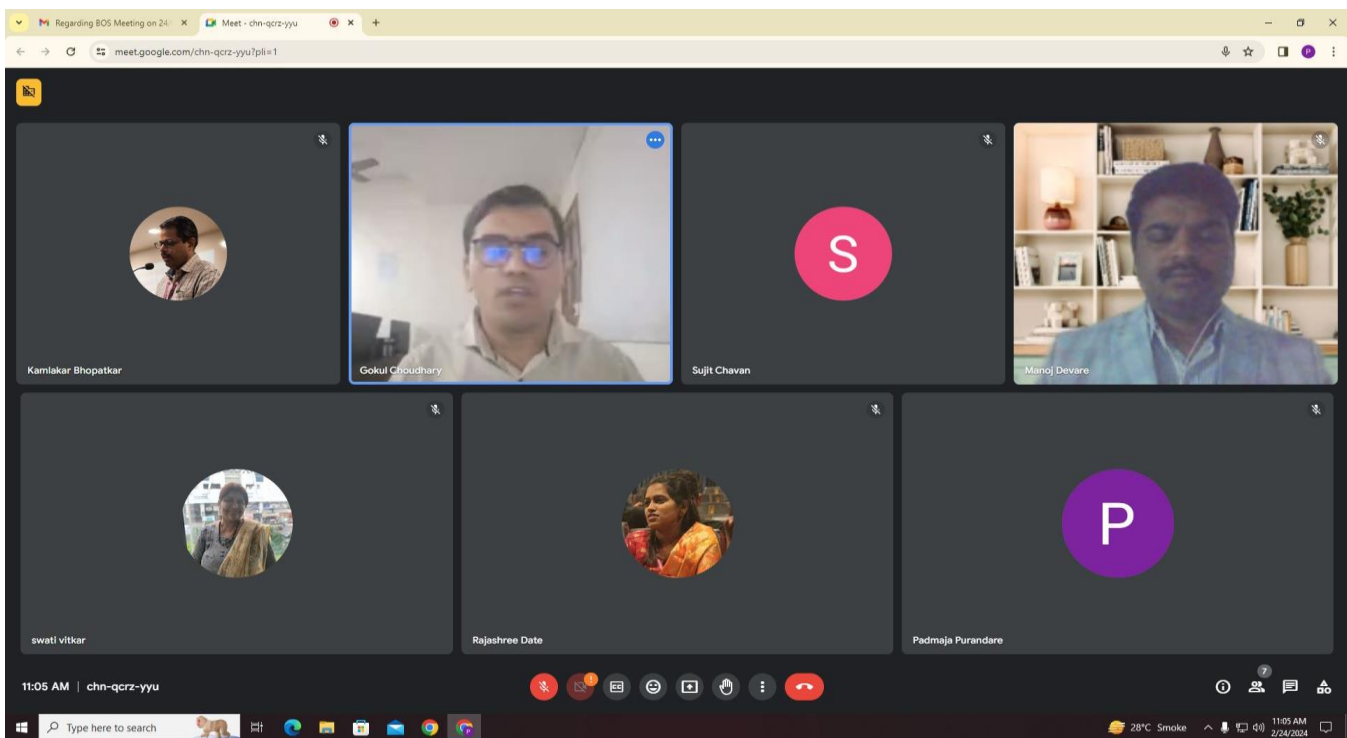
Agenda 3 - Any other matter with the permission of the chair.
