**Implementation-of-the-ATKT-Rules-for-Progression-in-Undergraduate-UG-and-Post-Graduate-PG-programme(2025-26 onwards)**

**\*R-1 :Carry forward of marks in case of a learner who fails in the internal assessment and/or semester-end assessment in one or more subjects.**

**1. For a learner who passes the internal exam but fails in the semester-end examination:**

- A learner who passes in the internal examination but fails in the semester-end examination of the course shall reappear for the semester-end examination of that course . However, his/her marks of the internal examination shall be carried over and he/she shall be entitled to the grade obtained by him/her on passing.

**2. For a learner who passes the semester-end examination but fails in the internal assessment:**

- A learner who passes in the semester-end examination but fails in the internal assessment of the course shall reappear for the Internal examination of that course . However, his/her marks of the Semester End Examination shall be carried over and he/she shall be entitled to the grade obtained by him/her on passing.

**\*R-2:Rules for Progression (Allowed to keep terms-ATKT)**

**For UG programmes:**

1. A learner shall be allowed to keep the term for Semester II irrespective of the number of courses of failure in Semester I.
2. A learner shall be allowed to keep the term for Semester III if he/she scores 32 or more Cumulative credits from Semester I & Semester II.
3. A learner shall be allowed to keep the term for Semester IV irrespective of the number of courses of failure in Semester III.
4. A learner shall be allowed to keep the term for Semester V if he/she scores 76 or more Cumulative credits from Semester I, II, III & IV.
5. A learner shall be allowed to keep the term for Semester VI irrespective of the number of courses of failure in Semester V.
6. The result of Semester VI shall be withheld by the College till the student passes all the Semesters from Semester I to Semester V.

SY Sem III	22 Credits	Full Pass
SY Sem III	0 - 20 Credits	Can appear for Sem IV
Sem I + Sem II + Sem III + Sem IV	88 Credits	Full Pass, Promoted to TY Sem V
Sem I + Sem II + Sem III + Sem IV	Less than 76 Credits	Drop
TY Sem V	22 Credits	Full Pass
TY Sem V	0 - 20 Credits	Can appear for Sem VI
Sem I + Sem II + Sem III + Sem IV + Sem V + Sem VI	132 Credits	Graduate

### Undergraduate Degree Eligibility Criteria Under NEP

A learner admitted under NEP must earn all his/her credits of each semester to pass within a period of seven academic years (beginning from the academic year of his/her admission) to be eligible for an undergraduate degree.

**R-3**

**For PG Programmes:**

The result of PG Semester IV shall be kept in abeyance until the learner passes each of PG Semester I, Semester II, and Semester III.
