

Implementation-of-the-ATKT-Rules-for-Progression-in-Undergraduate-UG-and-Post-Graduate-PG-programme(2025-26 onwards)

\*R-I :Carry forward of marks in case of a learner who fails in the internal assessment and/or semester-end assessment in one or more subjects.

- 1. For a learner who passes the internal exam but fails in the semester-end examination:
- A learner who passes in the internal examination but fails in the semester-end examination of the course shall reappear for the semester-end examination of that course. However, his/her marks of the internal examination shall be carried over and he/she shall be entitled to the grade obtained by him/her on passing.
- 2. For a learner who passes the semester-end examination but fails in the internal assessment:
- A learner who passes in the semester-end examination but fails in the internal assessment
  of the course shall reappear for the Internal examination of that course. However, his/her
  marks of the Semester End Examination shall be carried over and he/she shall be entitled
  to the grade obtained by him/her on passing.

## n\*R-2:Rules for Progression (Allowed to keep terms-ATKT)

#### For UG programmes:

- 1. A learner shall be allowed to keep the term for Semester II irrespective of the number of courses of failure in Semester I.
- 2. A learner shall be allowed to keep the term for Semester III if he/she scores 32 or more Cumulative credits from Semester I & Semester II.
- 3. A learner shall be allowed to keep the term for Semester IV irrespective of the number of courses of failure in Semester III.
- 4. A learner shall be allowed to keep the term for Semester V if he/she scores 76 or more Cumulative credits from Semester I, II, III & IV.
- 5. A learner shall be allowed to keep the term for Semester VI irrespective of the number of courses of failure in Semester V.
- 6. The result of Semester VI shall be withheld by the College till the student passes all the Semesters from Semester I to Semester V.

# Undergraduate Degree Eligibility Criteria Under NEP

A learner admitted under NEP must earn all his/her credits of each semester to pass within a period of <u>seven</u> academic years (beginning from the academic year of his/her admission) to be eligible for an undergraduate degree.
