Preface

The National Education Policy 2020 (NEP) formulated in response to the need to harness full human potential and develop well-rounded competent individuals by providing the right environ to enable access to inclusive and equitable quality education includes provision for lifelong learning, awareness of new areas of knowledge, skill development to meet industrial demands for economic development, multidisciplinary studies to develop a comprehensive view of issues from a realistic paradigm, holistic approach to education, rootedness to the cultural ethos and moral values, cultivating scientific temperament and problem-solving attitude. The policy aims at promoting critical thinking, innovation and creativity to enable the use and promotion of higher order thinking skills. NEP envisages the development of guidelines for curriculum and credit framework for four year undergraduate programmes, regulations prescribing a minimum standard and the procedure for the award of the one year Certificate, two year Diploma, three years Bachelor Degree, four years Bachelor Degree (Research/ Honors) and Master's degree with multiple entry and exit options and transformation of HEIS into multidisciplinary institutions.

From this academic year, VESASC as an Autonomous College, is implementing NEP for the third year students as per the guidelines given by Government of Maharashtra through the 20th April 2023GR.

Bachelors of Commerce in Finance (B.com – Finance) an undergraduate three-year degree/four-year honors program is a comprehensive curriculum that provides students with a strong foundation in financial theory and practice. It is a rigorous programme which will equip learners with a strong financial foundation and the necessary quantitative skills, as well as teaching the logic behind the use of specific finance techniques and financial decision-making.

The program intends to prepare students for entry level careers in the field of Investment Banking, Financial advisory, Wealth management, Financial Analyst and much more.
