# Executive Summary

(Academic Year 2024–25)

The academic year 2024–25 at VESASC was marked by growth across teaching, research, outreach, and holistic development. All the activities demonstrate the College's commitment to nurturing knowledgeable, skilled, and socially responsible graduates. By balancing academics with co-curricular, extra-curricular, and value-based education, VESASC reinforced its vision of education as a comprehensive journey that prepares students to contribute meaningfully to society.

- **Teaching–Learning**

The academic year 2024–25 at VESASC witnessed a dynamic expansion of teaching–learning practices aimed at making education more interactive, experiential, and application-based. Each initiative sought to extend classroom learning into practical spaces where knowledge could be contextualized. **8 major activities including workshops and guest lectures were organised by different departments.**

- **Innovative Sessions:**

- Session titled *Teaching Photography on the Ground* was conducted. Seventy students attended, where mobile photography skills in expert/pro mode were taught outside the classroom.
- A Workshop on *Financial Planning and Wealth Management* under the PM-USHA grant was attended by 145 students and three faculty members.

- **Experiential Learning through Events:**

- FUN FIEST and Games of Thrones were conducted under the subject Event Marketing, enabling students to learn marketing principles through event organization.
- A Masterclass on Digital Marketing Industry Trends and Career exposed 55 students to industry insights.
- A session on Reactions and Rearrangements for M.Sc. students was conducted
- As part of National Science Day, a lecture on Nature-Inspired Algorithms: The Science Behind Smarter Solutions was delivered by Dr. Suman Madan.

- **Skill-Based Learning:**

- An interactive activity Trace the Truth (17th February 2025), attended by 79 students, integrated problem-solving into pedagogy.

- These teaching–learning innovations bridged theory and practice, improved student participation, and cultivated higher-order thinking. The emphasis on workshops, masterclasses, and experiential learning reaffirmed VESASC’s commitment to holistic pedagogy.

- **Curriculum Development**

Curriculum development during 2024–25 reflected the college’s focus on making academic programs relevant, future-oriented, and skill-based. Programs were enriched with guest lectures, workshops, alumni interactions, and soft skill development activities. **15 activities including workshops and guest lectures were organised by different departments.**

- **Guest Lectures and Industry Linkages:**

- Employability Skills in Chemistry by Mr. Vighnesh Nalawde guided students on career pathways in science.
- Navigating Commodities and Derivatives Market by Dr. Neha Verma enhanced students’ understanding of spot vs. future markets, risk mitigation, and career opportunities in derivatives.

- **Entrepreneurship and Innovation:**

An Entrepreneurship Workshop included 53 student-run stalls and participation from nearly 500 students. This event encouraged creativity, market research, and business planning among budding entrepreneurs.

- **Alumni Engagement:**

The College celebrated its 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary with an Alumni Meet, bringing together 60 alumni and current students for cultural programs, networking, and knowledge sharing.

- **Skill-Building Activities:**

- (i) Campus to Corporate by Ms. Juily Patil highlighted workplace readiness and professional behavior.
- (ii) A Hands-on Training in Technical Analysis taught students about chart patterns, candlesticks, and trading psychology.

- **Other Activities:**

- (i) Games like Wordle in Physics and Yes/No Partner Game engaged students in conceptual learning.
- (ii) An expert session on Relationship Hacks to Survive and Thrive was attended by 53 students.

Curriculum enrichment activities expanded student competencies beyond textbooks, focusing on employability, entrepreneurship, and holistic skill development. The integration of expert talks, alumni involvement, and soft skills strengthened both academic and professional readiness.

- **Research**

Research at VESASC this year reflected both academic rigor and social relevance. Each project, each paper, and each presentation sought to answer questions that mattered to society, from health and sustainability to culture and technology. The College underscored its belief that research sustains and strengthens the academic process.

- **Faculty Research:**

- Faculty members engaged in projects across diverse fields such as sustainable finance, green chemistry, microbial genomics, psychological resilience, AI in education, and renewable energy.
- Several participated in national and international conferences, presenting original work that aligned with global academic debates.

- **Publications:**

- 23 Research papers of various faculty members were published in different journals including UGC CARE, Scopus and Peer reviewed.
- 11 Research papers of various faculty members were presented in different National and International conferences.
- 22 books and chapters in books were authored by different faculty members.

- **Multidisciplinary National Conference** - The Multidisciplinary National Conference on “Building A Sustainable Nation: Recent Developments, Policies, Practices and Perspectives” organized by the Research Circle of Vivekanand Education Society’s College of Arts, Science and Commerce (Autonomous), under the aegis of PM USHA, in collaboration with Vijnana Bharati was organized. The objective was to bring together academicians, researchers, and emerging scientists to share ideas, explore innovative approaches, and discuss practical solutions for promoting sustainability across Science, Technology, Social Sciences, Commerce and Management. The event featured 93 oral presentations, including 17 online presentations offering a platform for the exchange of ideas and showcasing innovations with the potential to improve lives and advance sustainability. Total 135 participants attended the conference. The conference concluded with a collective commitment to advancing sustainability through multidisciplinary

collaboration and innovative thinking. These papers were published in UGC CARE journal.

- **Student Research:**

Ravee Naik (TYBBA) won the Best Paper Award at Vision for Viksit Bharat National Competition. Teams qualified for the Aavishkar Research Convention, presenting innovations in wastewater treatment, agriculture, computing, and mental health.

With publications, conferences, and awards, VESASC solidified its identity as a research-driven institution. Faculty and student work reinforced the principle that education finds its true purpose when research contributes directly to knowledge and society.

- **Outreach / Extension Activities**

Outreach and extension activities during 2024–25 strengthened VESASC’s social responsibility mission. Through NSS, collaborations, and partnerships with NGOs, the College ensured that students engaged with real-world issues and communities.

- **NSS Initiatives:**

- The NSS Unit of 149 volunteers conducted blood donation drives, health check-ups, sanitation programs, and e-waste collection campaigns.

- Awareness rallies on HIV/AIDS, gender sensitivity, and road safety combined education with service.

- **Rural Camp at Atgaon:** A 7-day residential camp exposed students to rural challenges. Activities included literacy programs, sanitation drives, and health camps benefitting 900 villagers.

- **Collaborations:** Ties with NGOs and civic bodies ensured outreach programs were systematic and impactful. Joint activities extended the scope of College engagement beyond campus.

- **Environmental Actions:**

Tree plantation drives and waste management campaigns instilled sustainable practices among students. Special programs emphasized ecological responsibility as a civic duty.

Outreach activities demonstrated that education at VESASC integrates civic engagement, compassion, and sustainability. Students imbibed values of service, leadership, and empathy, preparing them for meaningful roles in society.

- **Co-Curricular Activities**

Co-curricular activities remained central to developing critical skills, creativity, and confidence. Sessions across disciplines reinforced classroom knowledge while broadening intellectual and social capacities.

- **Academic Competitions:**

- *Wordle in Physics* (8th February 2025) challenged students to apply subject knowledge in creative ways.

- *Yes or No Partner Game* (15th February 2025) sharpened logical reasoning.

- *Trace the Truth* (17th February 2025) integrated critical analysis into problem-solving tasks.

- **Skill Development Workshops:**

- *The Ultimate Interview Prep* (18th February 2025) focused on interview skills and personal branding.

- A session on *Relationship Hacks to Survive and Thrive* improved emotional intelligence.

- **Soft Skills and Employability:**

- *Campus to Corporate* (8th February 2025) prepared students for workplace environments.

- Guest lectures on Google Analytics, derivatives trading, and financial planning built professional competencies.

Co-curricular programs ensured that learning was not limited to academics but extended to problem-solving, communication, and leadership. Students developed resilience and adaptability — skills crucial for lifelong success.

- **Study Tours**

Study tours at VESASC during 2024–25 were carefully planned to connect classroom learning with real-world exposure. Visits across faculties gave students practical insights into industry operations, research environments, and cultural heritage.

- **Science and Technology Visits:** Students visited research laboratories and industrial plants, observing experiments and processes first-hand. These visits bridged the gap between theoretical concepts in science with applied research practices.

- **Commerce and Management Visits:** Industrial tours to financial institutions, manufacturing units, and service organizations gave learners a practical understanding of organizational workflows, HR practices, and supply chain management. Sessions with professionals during visits exposed students to business ethics, customer relations, and financial planning models.

- **Humanities and Cultural Tours:** Study trips included heritage walks and cultural visits, allowing students to appreciate history, society, and the arts in context. Such tours enriched classroom discussions and broadened perspectives.

Study tours proved invaluable in helping students apply theory to practice. Faculty observed increased curiosity, teamwork, and reflective learning, as students were able to relate classroom learning to lived experiences.

- **Career Guidance and Placement**

VESASC recognizes career readiness as a crucial dimension of education. The College, through its Placement Cell and collaborative initiatives, ensured that students were equipped for both employment and higher studies.

- **Skill Development:**

- Sessions like *Campus to Corporate* and *The Ultimate Interview Prep* trained students in soft skills, professional etiquette, and communication.
- Specialized workshops introduced students to Google AdWords, Analytics, and Technical Analysis, combining theoretical and practical exposure.

- **Career Awareness:**

- Guest lectures on *Employability Skills in Chemistry, Commodities and Derivatives*, and *Financial Risk Management* broadened students' perspectives on sector-specific opportunities.
- Hands-on activities allowed students to simulate real-world problem-solving.

- **Placement Drives:**

- The Placement Cell coordinated recruitment drives with companies across sectors, securing opportunities for final-year students.
- Mock interviews, resume writing workshops, and aptitude tests were conducted to improve preparedness.

Career guidance and placement initiatives bridged the transition from campus to corporate and academia to industry. Students were better prepared for competitive markets, equipped with technical knowledge and confidence.

- **Extra-Curricular Activities**

Extra-curricular activities in 2024–25 reflected VESASC's commitment to nurturing talent and creativity alongside academics. Students actively engaged in cultural, artistic, and athletic pursuits.

- **Cultural Achievements:**
  - Anuja Mhaiskar (SYCS) won 2nd Prize in Folk Dance at B.K. Birla College (February 2025).
  - College-level debates, essay competitions, theatre, and music performances provided platforms for creative expression.
- **Sports Achievements:**
  - Arpit Bandekar (TYCS) secured 2nd Prize in Carrom (Men's Doubles) at the University of Mumbai tournament.
  - Students represented the college in cricket, badminton, and athletics, demonstrating discipline and teamwork.
- **Student-Led Clubs:**
  - Photography, literature, and entrepreneurship clubs organized fests and competitions.
  - Cultural festivals brought together performances, exhibitions, and talent showcases. These engagements developed creativity, leadership, and team spirit. They complemented academic learning by nurturing confidence, resilience, and adaptability in students.

- Voter awareness campaigns and road safety rallies built civic consciousness.

- **Celebration of Special Days:**

- Independence Day, Republic Day, International Women's Day, and World Environment Day were celebrated with cultural and reflective activities.

This comprehensive approach instilled in students respect for equity, environment, values, and community. Special day celebrations strengthened unity and pride, while outreach initiatives fostered responsibility and compassion.

- **Faculty Development**

The College emphasized that continuous faculty development is vital for academic excellence. Faculty were encouraged and supported in professional growth, research, and innovative teaching practices.

- **Workshops and Training:**

- ICT-enabled teaching, pedagogy workshops, and curriculum enrichment sessions were conducted.

- **Research and Publication Support:**

- Faculty were encouraged to publish in peer-reviewed journals and present at conferences.

- Institutional backing was extended for attending national and international academic events.

- Cross-disciplinary research collaborations strengthened institutional culture.

- Faculty participated in orientation and refresher courses at UGC-HRDC and other recognized centres.

- Exposure to global trends helped align teaching with international standards.

Faculty development initiatives enriched pedagogy, boosted research output, and improved mentoring. Students benefited directly from innovative teaching practices and globally aware faculty guidance.

- **Other Activities**

- **Faculty Achievements:** Dr. Heena Ganatra received the *Best Teacher in Economics* award; faculty participated in essay competitions and short-term courses; Dr. Dinesh Navale published a book chapter and served as a resource person for workshops.
- **Parent-Teacher Engagement:** Multiple meetings were held for FY, SY, TY, and B.Com students to discuss performance and upcoming exams.
- **Library Initiatives:** Renovation inauguration, Dspace and MyLoft training, quiz competitions, and best user awards.
- **Competitions and Practical Learning:** *Geopreneur, Innovista, Beat Bazaar,* and *E-commerce Simulation Workshops* provided hands-on learning in entrepreneurship, event marketing, and digital business skills.
- **Cultural and Alumni Events:** Silver Jubilee celebrations, alumni meets, and film screenings strengthened alumni-student engagement.
- **Peer Learning and Consultancy:** AI-based storyboard sessions and microbiology consultancy projects enhanced technical and research skills.
- **Publications and Tech Initiatives:** The 6th edition of the tech magazine *TecKnow* was launched.

### Summary of Activities under PM USHA

## 1. Teaching - Learning

- **On 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2024** - Department of Computer Science conducted Teaching Photography on the Ground, session outside the class on the ground to teach students how to capture photos using expert/pro mode in mobile phones. Majority of the class students (70) attended the session as part of Photography as OE in SFC.
- **On 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2024** - Department of Banking and Insurance (BBI) conducted Workshop on Financial Planning and Wealth Management by Ms. Yukti Gala which was attended by 145 students and 3 teachers. This Activity was done under the aegis of PM USHA Grant.
- **On 15<sup>th</sup> January, 2025:** Bachelor of Management Studies (BMS) department organized an event titled FUN FIEST under the subject of Event Marketing. The event aimed to enhance students' understanding and practical application of marketing concepts in event planning. Held in the College Auditorium, it had 81 participants.
- **3<sup>rd</sup> February 2025** - "Digital Marketing Industry Trends and Applications – Career Paths", A Masterclass Conducted for FY and SY Students of E-Commerce. 55 Students attended the session.
- **8<sup>th</sup> February 2025** - The Department of Chemistry organised a guest lecture for M.Sc. Chemistry students on Reactions and Rearrangements at 9:00 am to 11:00 am. A total of 25 students participated in the guest lecture.
- **17<sup>th</sup> February 2025** - The event titled "Trace the Truth" was conducted in the Auditorium from 11 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. by the Department of Management studies, with an attendance of 79 people.
- **28<sup>th</sup> February 2025** - On Science day, a session was organised by the VESASC Science departments, titled, "Nature inspired algorithms: The Science behind smarter solutions" under the aegis of PM-USHA. The resource person for the session was Dr. Suman Madan, Professor, School of Technology, ATLAS SkillTech University, on 28<sup>th</sup> Feb, 2025. The Computer Science department assisted in the overall conduct of the program.
- **05-03- 2025: The Bachelor of Management Studies (BMS) department** organized an event titled **GAMES OF THRONES** under the subject of Event Marketing. The event aimed to enhance students' understanding and practical application of marketing concepts in event planning. Approximately, **30 students** of SYBMS participated in the session.

## 2. Curriculum Development

- **1st February 2025** - The Department of Chemistry at VESASC successfully organized an informative and engaging guest lecture on "Employability Skills: Internship and Job Opportunities in Chemistry" under the aegis of PM-USHA, which was delivered by the esteemed speaker Mr. Vighnesh Nalawde. The event took place on 1st February 2025 from 12:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m. at the VESASC AV Room. The primary goal of the session was to equip students with essential skills and insights required to pursue internships and job opportunities in the field of Chemistry.
- **5th February 2025** - A guest lecture "Navigating Commodities and Derivatives Market" by Dr Neha Verma was organised by the Department of Business Administration under the aegis of PM-USHA. It successfully enriched students' knowledge of commodities and derivatives markets by providing them with theoretical concepts and practical applications. Students gained a better understanding of how different commodities are traded and the factors affecting their prices. The speaker enlightened students on Spot v/s Future markets and how investors use these markets to hedge risks or speculate on price movements. Insights were also given into derivatives trading strategies, including how businesses and investors use futures and options for risk mitigation. The session increased the awareness of career opportunities in commodity trading, derivatives analysis, and financial risk management. It was a highly engaging and interactive session that encouraged students to think critically about market dynamics and financial instruments. 73 students of TY BBA and SY BBA attended the talk.
- **7th February 2025** - The Department of Economics hosted a unique Entrepreneurship Workshop on February 7th and 8th, under the aegis of PM USHA. The workshop aimed to empower individuals to turn their passions into profitable ventures, focusing on making money by selling their own goods. The event covered various aspects of entrepreneurship, including idea generation, market research, business planning, financial management, and networking. Participants had the opportunity to learn from experienced entrepreneurs and industry experts, and gain valuable insights into the world of entrepreneurship. The response to the workshop was overwhelming, with a total of 53 stalls registered from various departments of the college. The whole college around 500 students participated in the event, making it a grand success.

- **7th and 8th February 2025** - Arpit Bandekar of TY CS won the 2nd Prize in Inter-Collegiate Carrom Tournament 2024-25 Men's Double organised by University of Mumbai on 7th and 8th February, at KBP Hinduja College of Commerce (Autonomous)
- **8th February 2025** - A word making game “Wordle In Physics” with one or two letters as a hint related to Physics. FY, SY and TY students participated in it.
- **8th February, 2025** - The Department of Management Studies commemorated a significant milestone—the completion of 25 years of academic excellence. To celebrate this achievement and strengthen the bond between the alumni and the current students, an Alumni Meet was organised, marking the occasion with a series of cultural programs, speeches, and networking opportunities. The event began at 2:30 PM and concluded at 7:00 PM, bringing together alumni, faculty members, and students to reflect on the department’s journey and celebrate the achievements of all those who have been a part of it. Sixty alumni participated in it.
- **8th February, 2025** - The department of Computer Science conducted an activity titled " Campus to Corporate" on Soft skill development for SYCS Students under the aegis of PM-USHA on 8th Feb ,2025 at 12:00 pm. The speaker for the session was Ms. Juliy Patil, Program Specialist at TNS India Foundation.
- **8th February, 2025** - Anuja Mhaiskar of SY CS participated in Folk Dance Competition at B.K. Birla College on 8th Feb, 2025 and won 2nd prize.
- **15th February 2025** - A partner game “Yes or No” in which one partner will ask a question related to an object that the other partner knows; the other partner can give an answer in yes or no only. FY, SY and TY students of B.Sc. Physics participated in it.
- **15th February 2025** - The Department of Business Administration organised a guest lecture on “Boost your ROI: Google Adwords and Analytics Simplified” under the aegis of PM USHA on 15th February 2025, from 12 noon to 2.00 PM. The session was conducted by Dr. Neha Verma, an Assistant Professor at VES Institute of Management. The session was attended by 75 students and covered the key concepts of Google Analytics and Google AdWords. A hands-on demonstration allowed students to explore the Google Analytics and AdWords dashboards, followed by practical examples and case studies that highlighted effective digital marketing strategies.
- **15th February 2025** - The Department of Finance organized a hands-on training session on "Technical Analysis" on February 15, 2025 under the aegis of PM-USHA. Conducted by expert Mr. Randhir Gaikwad, the session aimed to equip 34 students with practical skills to analyse financial markets. Key topics included chart types, trends, support and resistance

levels, and volume analysis. Mr. Gaikwad explained patterns like head and shoulders, triangles, and candlestick formations. Students gained hands-on experience using charting platforms. Risk management and trading psychology were also covered. The session concluded with a Q&A and a vote of thanks by Arti Choudhary. Participants left with a strong foundation in technical analysis.

- **15th February 2025** - A Birding Session was organised by CS Department's Coordinator, Mr. Kamlakar Bhopatkar on 15th Feb, 2025 for Green Club Students of VESASC.
- **17th February 2025** - IWSA session on Unravelling Microbial Genomes was conducted from 11.00 am to 1.00 pm in collaboration with IWSA and BRNS under the popular lecture series. The talk has provided us the understanding of current trends in microbial genomics and its potential to address both global health challenges and environmental issues. It also gave us insight on its transformative impact in biomedical research. The resource person was Dr. Gargi Bindal, Scientific officer E, Applied genomics section, BARC.
- **18th February 2025** - The Department of Management Studies under the PM-Usha initiative, conducted an insightful session titled “The Ultimate Interview Prep: Skills, Attire, and Communication” on 18th February 2025 to equip students with essential interview skills, professional presence, and effective communication strategies. The session was led by Dr. Sneha Vaskar, an Assistant Professor at Narsee Monjee College of Commerce and Economics, Personal Brand Consultant, and Soft Skills Trainer. The session provided students with practical insights into interview preparation, professional attire, communication techniques, and confidence-building strategies. Dr. Vaskar’s interactive approach and real-life examples made the session engaging and informative.
- An Expert Talk on the topic 'Relationship Hacks to Survive and Thrive!' by Psychotherapist Ms. Asira Chirmuley was organized by the Department of Psychology under the aegis of PM-USHA grant. A total of 53 students attended the session, which aimed at enhancing Interpersonal skills and promoting Emotional Intelligence among our students.

This session fostered collaboration, enhanced creativity and equipped students with practical knowledge of AI applications in project development and use them in their innovative presentations.
- On **15<sup>th</sup> January, 2025**: FYCS Student, Rutuja Kharat won the 2nd prize in the 14th Annual Book Review Competition organized by college.
- On **20<sup>th</sup> January, 2025**: The BMS department organized the Beat Bazaar Event Marketing, allowing students to explore event marketing and hands-on planning of events. Also, performance by guest artist Rahul. 103 students participated.
- On **20<sup>th</sup> January, 2025** : B.Com (Banking & Insurance) organised “**The Investment Awareness Program with UTI Mutual Fund**” by guest speaker Mr. Tanuj Podar who educated students on financial planning and investing in mutual funds. The program included three separate sessions, covering topics such as portfolio management, asset allocation, and long-term financial growth. A total of 229 students participated across all sessions: 96 in Session I, 90 in Session II, and 43 in Session III.
- On **20<sup>th</sup> January, 2025** : BBA department organised session on “**UTI Mutual Fund Awareness**” was held, led by Mr. Tanuj Poddar. The session aimed to educate students about investment opportunities in mutual funds, explaining the basics of investing, the concept of

compounding, and highlighting various mutual fund schemes. 71 students attended the event.

At the department level, various events were conducted, with winners advancing to the final competition. ## February 2025

## **2. Career in Accounting & Finance for Youth (CAFY) & Super Mega Career Counselling Program**

### **Purpose/Objective:**

The session also aimed to provide comprehensive career counselling to help students make informed decisions about their future paths.

### **Outcomes:**

- Insight into the skills and qualifications required for success in these fields.
- Motivation and guidance to explore their career interests and seek further counselling to make informed decisions about their future.

## **3. How to Earn Scholarship for Higher Education?**

### **Purpose/Objective:**

The primary goal of this session was to raise awareness among students about the various higher education opportunities available abroad and to provide them with practical strategies for securing scholarships to fund their studies at foreign universities. By the end of the session, students were expected to have a clearer understanding of the scholarship landscape and be inspired to actively pursue these opportunities.

### **Outcomes:**

By the end of the session, students gained:

- A comprehensive understanding of the various scholarship opportunities available for higher education abroad.
- Clarity on the application process and the components of a strong scholarship application.

- Inspiration and motivation to actively plan and pursue scholarships, enhancing their chances of studying at foreign universities.

#### **4. Career Guidance for MPSC & UPSC Preparation**

##### **Purpose/Objective -**

The session intended to create an awareness amongst the students about the Career Guidance and Placement Cell activities, several openings in the Government jobs and to encourage them to identify their strengths, skills.

##### **Outcomes -**

Number of students attended - 106

The students got clarity on the stages of the UPSC examination - the Preliminary Exam (Prelims), the Mains Exam, and the Interview (Personality Test). The students were briefed about the subjects, general studies and optional subjects. The major takeaway from the session was a clear understanding of the steps that needs to be taken for preparing for the toughest examination in India. The session encouraged and inspired students to think of planning for the most coveted positions in the country's civil services

#### **5. Workshop on Introduction to Python**

##### **Purpose/Objective:**

The primary aim of this workshop was to introduce non-IT students to Python programming, emphasizing its versatility and applicability across various fields. The session sought to increase awareness and understanding of Python technologies, demonstrating how they can be leveraged in diverse domains such as data analysis, automation, web development, and more.

##### **Outcomes:**

Number of students attended - 43

By the end of the workshop, students achieved:

- Hands-on experience with basic Python coding, fostering confidence to explore programming further.

#### **6. Resume writing, GD, PI Guidance Session for Third Year Science Students**

**Purpose/Objective:**

The primary aim of this session was to equip third-year science students with essential skills and knowledge regarding the various components of the recruitment process, including resume writing, group discussions, and personal interviews. By the end of the session, students were expected to have a clear understanding of how to effectively prepare their resumes, participate in group discussions, and excel in personal interviews.

**Outcomes:**

Number of students attended - 36

**TNS India Foundation Campus to Corporate Career C2C Program**

**Purpose/Objective:**

The Campus to Corporate (C2C) Career Program aimed to bridge the gap between academic learning and professional expectations by equipping students with essential soft skills and practical knowledge required for a successful transition into the corporate world. ## 8. Extracurricular activities
