Proceedings of the Meeting

- The meeting commenced with a welcome address by the Chairperson, Prof.Dr. Varsha Ganatra.
- The previous Minutes of Meeting were reviewed and approved by all members.

1. Syllabus Revision (First Year, Second Year, Third Year)

- No major changes were proposed for the syllabus of Semesters I, III, and V. However, minor revisions in Second Year Semester III (Managerial Economics) were discussed and approved by the Board of Studies.

2. Programme Outcomes and Course Outcomes

- The proposed changes in the mapping of Programme Outcomes (POs) and Course Outcomes (COs) with Bloom's Taxonomy were discussed in detail during the Board of Studies meeting. After thorough deliberation, the revised mapping framework was reviewed and approved by the members.

3. Fourth Year Honors Program (B.Com E-Commerce)

- The Chairperson referred to the discussion held in the previous meeting regarding the eligibility and admission for the Fourth Year Honors Program. Prof. Dr. (Mrs.) Varsha Ganatra elaborated on the NEP framework for the four-year Bachelor's Degree (Honours) (B.Com-Ecommerce) Degree Programme which was as follows- A (B.Com-Ecommerce) graduate under NEP is eligible to take admission to B.Com-Ecommerce (Honours) Programme, provided the student has attained 132 credits at 3 years UG level. The student will attain the B.Com-Ecommerce (Honours Degree) if he attains a total of 176 credits after 4 years. If a student completes B.Com-Ecommerce (Honours) and has a score of 75% and above in each of the semesters, then he is eligible to take admission in the PhD. program after completion of the entrance examination as per the guidelines of the University of Mumbai.
- A class-level survey indicated low student inclination, with most students opting for MBA and other professional courses.
- It was decided not to implement the Fourth Year Honors Program in the upcoming academic year.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks by the Chairperson.
