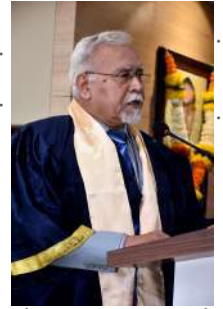

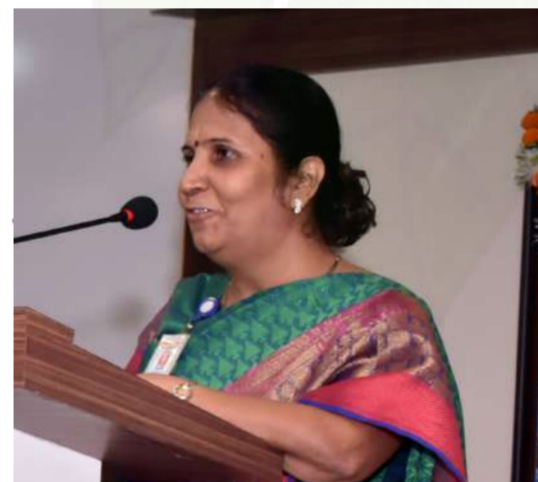

With my satire partner away, my jokes might lose their flair.

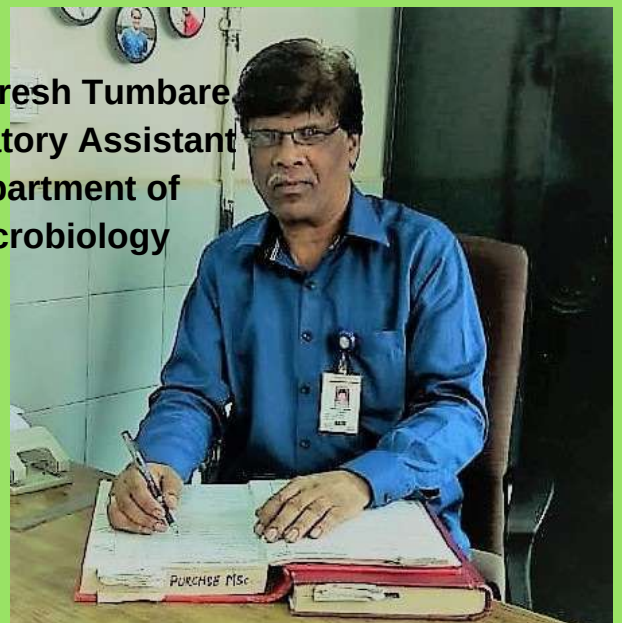
But I guess you need to go, as you become free from this phase of life.

I wish you the best for a beginning that is fresh and charming as a new wife.

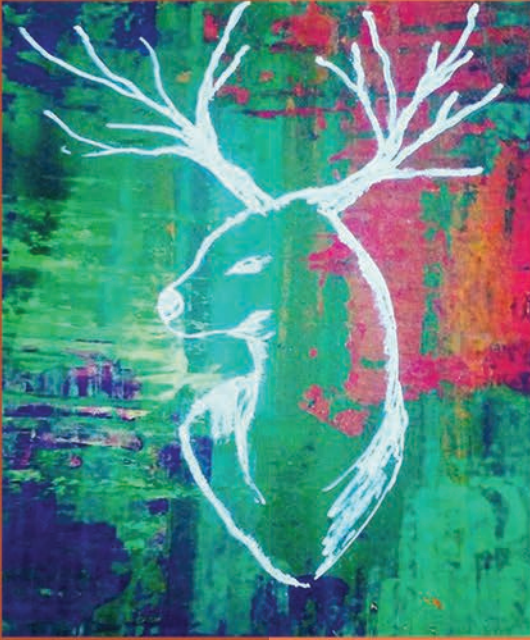
And when I miss you too much, I guess what I shall do,
