Highlights

The academic year 2018-19 proved as hectic as ever with events happening almost spontaneously and catching us in their midst!

Intra/Inter collegiate events in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities along with subject specific all India level written tests continued even as the enthusiasm in sports, NSS and Outreach activities continued unabated. When students were not busy in these, they honed their skills and widened their horizons by participating in various workshops and seminars where they even presented papers. This was more than matched by the courses/ seminars attended by faculty along with an impressive list of publications by them.

A brief of the NSS activities for the academic year 2018-19 is as follows:

- **Tree Plantation Program**

Two plantation Programmes have been conducted during 2018-19: On account of World Environment Day on 12th June, 2018 and on Van Mahotsava on 1st July, 2018. It was done with the association with SPN Doshi Women's College.

- **Yoga Day Program**

A 7 days' yoga training camp was conducted by the **University of Mumbai** in collaboration with Kaivalyadham Institute and HSNCB Board. The inauguration of the program was held in R.D. National College, Bandra West. 300 volunteers from 115 institute practiced yoga for another 5 days along with practical and theory session of 2hrs daily. Our student Chaila Chowdhury from TYBMS was a part of this camp.

From 21st June 2019 to 23rd June 2019 **Yoga week was celebrated in the College**. A talk cum demonstration lecture was arranged on 21st June 2018. By Shri Durgadas Sawant (Vice Chairman of Yoga VidyaNiketana, Vashi, Navi Mumbai) on "Yoga for Health and Harmony. The following days Yoga practice session was continued.

On the occasion of platinum Jubilee of MSNC Board of Yoga, a **Demonstration Program** was organised by NSS Unit of University of Mumbai 2nd Feb, 2019. Five volunteers and 1 yoga intern from VESASC College attended the program.

- **Blood Donation Camp**

Two Blood Donation camps were organized in the College:

On 21st July, 2018 VES College of Arts Science and Commerce, Chembur in association with L.T.M.G. Hospital, Raheja Blood Bank, Rotary Club of Chembur and Think Foundation Organised Blood Donation Camp

and Thalassemia Check-up Camp. The Motive of this camp was “Your Blood will save someone’s life”. 282 students have done thalassemia check-up and 120 students have donated the Blood for good cause.

On 22nd Feb, 2019 a 2nd Blood donation camp was organised in association with Borivali Blood Bank & Raheja Blood bank. Total number of donors is 154. About 40 volunteers actively participated in this event to make this event successful.

- **Swachhata Drive**

On 29th July, 2018 16 volunteers visited **Maldunge village** (Swatch Bharat Summer Internship Camp). A rally was organised with the Swatch Bharat slogan in which village kids also joined with volunteers and cleaned the village area. Hand Wash session activity was also performed with the help of games like ‘Soap Race’ and ‘Dog in the Bone’. About 160 villagers were benefited.

College Premises Cleaning was carried out on 8th September and 22nd September, 2018 NSS Volunteers cleaned entire College premises. Total 55 Volunteers were involved in this activity.

On 30th September, 2018, eight volunteers visited **Kalina Campus** for **Swachata Hi Seva** activity at University level. Volunteers cleaned the area allotted to them by removing unwanted grasses and also cleaning the waste. It was again organised on 150th Birthday of Mahatma Gandhi (2nd October) in which 5 volunteers participated on 14th October 2018 and Vice Chancellor of Mumbai university had a talk about the thoughts of Mahatma Gandhi and idea of Swachata.

On the occasion of “Gandhi Jayanti” on 2nd Oct, 2018 our NSS Unit had taken initiative to **clean Kurla Railway station premises**. Event started with cleanliness awareness rally, premises cleaning, and wall painting. Different slogans were written by the volunteers on the walls. In all 30 volunteers took part in this activity at Kurla Railway Station.
