Executive Summary: 2019-20 at a glance (Highlights)

In more ways than one, academic year 2019-20 was a very eventful one. It brought with it both glories and woes in the wake of the COVID 19 pandemic. On the curriculum front, along with the usual courses, six Certificate courses (including ACP) and three value added courses were conducted in the college. 27 students completed Field Projects/ Internships. They won numerous prizes at college, intercollegiate, university, state and national level across a wide variety of sports, cultural and academic events. Many of them took part in and excelled in live and online competitions. The VESASC General Ability Test or GAT for freshers was held for the very first time.

To mention a few of these many laurels brought to us by students:

1. Mr. Harish Anirudh Shah (T.Y.B.Sc.) participated in the 'Independence Cup Karate International Championship' and won a 'Silver Medal' and 'Bronze Medal'.
2. Mr. Maheshwar Vijay Ujagera (S.Y.B.Com.) participated in the '2nd and 3rd Aerial Sports National Championship' and won three 'Gold Medals'.
3. Ms. Pooja Yadav (T.Y.B.Sc.) won 'Silver Medal' in the '5 km Run' at the University level.
4. The college Girls team won 'Gold Medal' in the 'Inter College Sports Fest - Yuva Khel Summit 3.0' organized by Yuva Sena at Andheri Sports Complex.
5. Mr. Maheshwar Ujagera (SYBcom) winning the Prestigious Mr. University title.
6. Ms. Maitreyi Bokil from SYBCom won the first position in the Finals for Story Writing conducted by the University of Mumbai.
7. Mr. Mayur Khankal from TYBA won the Second Prize at the finals of the Elocution Competition conducted by the University of Mumbai, the Third Prize of Rs 5500 at the finals of the prestigious A.D. Shroff Elocution Competition conducted by the Forum of Free Enterprise as well as the Mr. Talentia title at the Intra collegiate event of our college, a true ambassador of our college indeed!
8. The student contingent sent by Department of Economics to the subject based festivals of Acharya (Arthmanthan) and MCC (Oikonomia) College won multiple prizes, bringing us the laural of the Best College Trophy.
9. Mr. Sagar Ramchandani, TYBSc presented his research paper at 'Avishkar' and secured Second Rank for his research paper at Final Round of Mumbai University level and First Rank at Final Round of Maharashtra State Inter-University level. He also won the BEST STUDENT AWARD in college.
10. Two teams sent by Department of Commerce presented a research paper at Mulund Commerce of Commerce secured the First Prize as well as the Consolation Prize.
11. TYBSc-Chemistry Students presented a paper at SIES College, Sion and secured the Second Prize.
12. Mr. Ajay Chavan of T.Y.BT, won 2nd Prize in an online "BioteCovid Poster Competition" organized by the Department of Biotechnology at K.C. College.
13. Miss Parnita Jadhav of TYBCom A has secured 1st place in online "Art Showcase competition" organized by DLLE and NSS unit of JES College.
14. Rohit Thakur from TYBCOM secured the second prize (trophy and a cash prize of Rs 1500/-) Inter-collegiate Book Review Competition at JM Patel College.

Departments across the college hosted their subject specific departmental festivals or mega events like "Saudagiri" (Financial Markets Dept.), Kaun Banega Physicist (An intercollegiate quiz by Physics Dept.), Euphony (Banking and Insurance department), Impressions (BMM Dept.), ARVESTUS (BAF Dept.), Mathemight (Maths Dept.), Sagacity (IT Dept.), Entrepreneurship Workshop (Economics Dept.), Innovision (Commerce Dept.), Psychedelia (Psychology Dept.) and VIHAAN (CS Dept.) This year our college also hosted the zone II Selection Round of Avishkar. As always, the College Festival, Talentia, Annual Day and Prize Distribution system were held amidst a lot of fanfare.

The Sindhi Circle was active through the year. Apart from running its Sindhi language course, it also kept alive the Sindhi culture with participation and laurels across Sindhi events in Mumbai. One of our students Ms. Simran Lund of SYBAF was awarded as BEST Female Model and secured the First Prize at "Jashan" (A

Celebration of Sindhiyat) in R.D. National College. Our students bagged the Best Choreography Award along with cash prize of rupees 2000 at Fusion 2.0 organized by Sindhu Youth Circle (Ulhasnagar).

The lockdown period in the wake of the pandemic also saw all teachers using ICT like never before to ensure effective teaching. They attended numerous webinars and training programmes to get familiar with various Learning Management Systems (LMS) and E-learning resources. Most faculty have also developed their own e-content and presentations for use once the teaching-learning begins in full swing. Six research projects by faculty had funds sanctioned and received from various agencies. Over 30 papers were published and reviewed. Teachers also attended many professional development programmes, viz., Orientation Programme, Refresher Course, Short Term Course, Faculty Development Programmes, Webinars/ Seminars etc.

The year 2019-20 saw many staff receiving awards and honours:

5. Mrs. Samhitha Sharma Kain won the **Best Presenter Award** for her paper in the International Webinar by Karleskar College, Nallasopore and Parul University, Gujrat on “Current trends, Policies & issues in the field of Commerce, Management, Economics, Law & Social Sciences”.
6. Mrs. Samhitha Sharma Kain won a **Certificate of Excellence (Third Prize)** for Innovative Idea Presentation at the VESASC National Level Webinar on “Steering HEIs in the wake of Covid-19: The way ahead for Academia”.
7. Ms. Rita Vazirani won the **Consolation Prize** for Innovative Idea Presentation at the VESASC National Level Webinar on “Steering HEIs in the wake of Covid-19: The way ahead for Academia”.

Ms. Arpita Sarkar won the **Third Prize for Poster presentation** on ‘Self-Care during COVID-19’ in a One Day International Weminar on ‘Impact of COVID-19 on Intellectual Health of Youngsters, it’s Remedial Measures & Use of ICT’, organised by Shankarlal Agrawal Science College, Salekasa, Gondia, Nagpur.

The VES College of Arts, Science and Commerce IQAC and Research Circle in association with Vijnana Bharati, Mumbai organised a four days National Webinar from 9th June to 12th June, 2020, (Time: 3.00 pm to 6.00 pm every day) on “Steering HEIs in the wake of Covid-19: The way ahead for Academia”. The inaugural day of the webinar had in attendance a host of dignitaries and well wishers as well as trustee members of VES family. Shri. Baldev Boolani (President of VES Society) and Advocate Dr. Laxman Kanal (Trustee in charge, VESASC) shared their thoughts about the impact of Covid-19 and also provided some insights about the outcome of the webinar and its relevance to academicians. Chief Guest Dr. Suhas Pednekar (Vice Chancellor, University of Mumbai) in his keynote address on the inaugural day presented his vision of higher education in the post Covid scenario. Other Chief Guesta on the following days were Dr. Ravindra Kulkarni (Pro-Vice Chancellor, Mumbai University), Dr. Vinod Patil (Director, Board of Examination and Evaluation, University of Mumbai) and Dr. Ganesh Hegde (Adviser, NAAC). The expert talks on the days’ **sub-themes** were delivered by Dr. (Ms) Kasturi Naik (Founder KIE, Certified Life coach, Image Consultant, EQ and NLP Practitioner), Ms. Upasana Saraf (HRD Head and Psychologist at Bombay Cambridge Gurukul Schools), Dr. Nagarjun G’s (Associate Professor, Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education, TIFR), Dr. Rahul Makhijani’s (Research Scientist, Facebook USA), Dr. Jayshree Shinde (Director, Teaching Learning Centre and Faculty Member, Department of Educational Technology, SNDT Women’s University), Dr. Bhaskaran Raman (Professor, Department of Computer Science and Engineering, IIT Bombay) and Mr. Karan Shah, (Founder, Indian Institute of Digital Education). The innovative ideas presentations(IIPs) held at the end of each day had practical

workable solutions related to each of the sub-themes. The webinar was broadcasted Live on Youtube and the live comments enabled a very fruitful Q&A session after each talk. Around 600 participants attended the webinar on all 4 days.

The College also organized a Seminar on ‘New Dimensions of NAAC Accreditation: Revisiting the SSR and AQAR in the Revised Accreditation Framework’ with 103 participants from 36 institutions on 8th August 2019.

Our college has always been active on the social front. A number of extension and outreach programmes were conducted in collaboration with industry, community and Non- Government Organizations. Our vibrant NSS Unit’s seven Days Residential Camp had the theme of “Swachh Bharat”. The NSS Volunteers participated in many different events such as sevadaan, skits, anti-drugs and other awareness programmes, poster making on various social evils, Tree Plantation Program, Yoga Day Programme, Blood Donation Camp, Swachhata Pakhwada as per the directives of Government of India (Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, RRC (Red Ribbon Club) Activities, Road Safety Awareness measures, Voter Awareness related Activity, Fit India Campaign in college, Plastic Ban Activity, Flood Donation Drive, Malaria Awareness Rally, Bone Marrow Donor Registration process etc. NSS unit activities continued during Lock down Period. Our Outreach Cell continued its collaboration with NGO’s and institutions such as NASEOH, Goonj and Umang to carry out a number of social activities. The Lifelong Learning and Extension Cell focused this year on population and career education. WDC and Value Lab of our college organized two days’ workshop (25/6/19 & 26/6/19) on Gender sensitivity, talks on “Awareness & management of gynecological disorders” and Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace and its annual event, “Expressions”. The SAW (Social Awareness Week), held every year by the BMM department, organized donations, rallies, clean-ups, awareness drives, visit to NGO’s, tree plantation and an ‘act’ on acid attack as a street play. BMS Department also organized the event of Social Entrepreneurial and Welfare Activity or SEWA for the third consecutive year.

All in all, it was an action packed year with lots of achievements and learnings. The college hopes to be back to business as usual sooner than later.

Innovation Ecosystem

Workshops/Seminars Conducted on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and Industry-Academia Innovative practices during the year

(i) Four days National Webinar on “Steering HEIs in the wake of Covid-19: The way ahead for Academia”: An Industry-Academia Innovative practice by VESASC

VES College of Arts, Science and Commerce IQAC and Research Circle in association with Vijnana Bharati, Mumbai organised a four days National Webinar from 9th June to 12th June, 2020, (Time: 3.00 pm to 6.00 pm every day) on “Steering HEIs in the wake of Covid-19: The way ahead for Academia”.

The inaugural day of the webinar had in attendance a host of dignitaries and well wishers as well as trustee members of VES family. Shri. Baldev Boolani (President of VES Society) and Advocate Dr. Laxman Kanal (Trustee in charge, VESASC) shared their thoughts about the impact of Covid-19 and also provided some insights about the outcome of the webinar and its relevance to academicians. Chief Guest Dr. Suhas Pednekar (Vice Chancellor, University of Mumbai) in his keynote address presented his vision of higher education in the post Covid scenario based on the three pillars of Accelerated Technology, Students Choice in a competitive world and Innovation in Education and urged the teachers to rise up to the call of Atmanirbhar Bharat put forth by the Prime Minister. The expert talks on the days’ sub-theme ‘Student Support and Coping Mechanisms’ by Dr. (Ms) Kasturi Naik (Founder KIE, Certified Life coach, Image Consultant, EQ and NLP Practitioner) and Ms. Upasana Saraf (HRD Head and Psychologist at Bombay Cambridge Gurukul Schools) covered the areas of concerns for the students from employability to coping with stress along with the varied aspects of virtual classrooms.

The sub-theme for the second day was ‘Innovations for Online Teaching, Learning and Research’. In his keynote address, Dr. Ravindra Kulkarni (Pro-Vice Chancellor, Mumbai University) emphasized on the importance of online teaching learning post Covid-19. He also highlighted how flexible (anytime, anywhere), personalised learning with the help of multimedia and internet will usher in a fourth revolution in the education sector. Dr. Nagarjun G’s (Associate Professor, Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education, TIFR) talk was rich in content. Amongst other things, he stressed upon the need to cultivate academic habits that will promote self learning and increase students’ engagement with the subjects and as an example shared experiences of the “Chatshala” model run by HBCSE which has continued to flourish and enable learning even in the lockdown period. The second speaker Dr. Rahul Makhijani’s (Research Scientist, Facebook USA) brilliant presentation opened the world of course development, teaching methodology and evaluation practices as followed in the foreign Universities.

On day three, Chief Guest Dr. Vinod Patil (Director, Board of Examination and Evaluation, University of Mumbai) spoke at length about the challenges faced while implementing past examination reforms and how the University continues to look into solutions in the face of the current challenge. In tandem with the sub-theme of the day viz ‘Opportunities and Challenges for On-line Examination and Evaluation’, the first panelist was Dr. Jayshree Shinde (Director, Teaching Learning Centre and Faculty Member, Department of Educational Technology, SNDT Women’s University) enlightened the participants about the importance of continuous comprehensive evaluation (CCE) as a value addition to the learning process and demonstrated various ICT based assessment tools that can enable CCE. The next panelist, Dr. Bhaskaran Raman (Professor, Department of Computer Science and Engineering, IIT Bombay) gave an interactive presentation to illustrate the important Do’s and Don’ts of online teaching and briefly explained the loopholes of online assessments. The energetic Mr. Karan Shah, (Founder, Indian Institute of Digital Education) gave a talk that covered various aspects and quick demonstrations of tools such as a LMS, Online proctoring and a certificate automator.

Under the sub-theme ‘Administrative and Managerial Issues’ on the last day, Chief Guest Dr. Ganesh Hegde (Adviser, NAAC) presented an excellent analysis on how NAAC evaluates HEIs and reiterated the core values of NAAC. Dr. Rajendra Shinde (Principal, St. Xavier’s College, Mumbai), the expert panelist for the day elaborated on various aspects of the functioning of his college and the changes and challenges the college foresees in the post Covid Era. The last speaker, Dr. A. V. Prasad (Assistant Adviser, NAAC) made a detailed presentation on the Data Validation and Verification and student satisfaction Survey process of NAAC.

The innovative ideas presentations(IIPs) held at the end of each day had practical workable solutions related to each of the sub-themes. Many Innovative Idea manuscripts were received. They were reviewed and only the shortlisted ones (around 20) were presented by the participants within a duration of three minutes. The accepted manuscripts will be published in the form of an E-Book. Further, the presentations were evaluated by Vijnana Bharati members on the basis of their content and relevance to the present scenario, the methodology proposed, its feasibility and the overall presentation and the following prizes were awarded.

Seven Days Residential Camp was organized at Shibir Maidan, Ambernath (East) from 28th Dec 2019 to 3rd Jan 2020. It was attended by 76 volunteers, 2 NSS POs and 4 NSS committee members & 3 other teachers. Theme of the camp was “Swachh Bharat”. The Volunteers participated in different events such as sevadaan, skit on Women Empowerment, Anti-drugs, Poster making on various social evils, NSS Logo etc. Guest lectures were organized on various topics such as Importance of Ayurveda medicine, Ways to improve Memory Power, CRR training. A session was conducted related to positive thinking and happiness related practices for the students. Volunteers inculcated different attributes like planning, organizing, controlling, motivating, budgeting, hard work, honesty, communication skills etc. at the camp. Volunteers also visited NAB, IDBI polytechnic and to Parle-G Factory and Fire Station. Campers visited the village Thakurpada which is located at about 2km from campsite. They sensitized the villagers on various social issues like Save Girl child; Keep your Surroundings Clean, Child Education, Women Empowerment, etc. through street plays. Self Defence skills were taught by seniors and a newspaper was made by the volunteers for each & every day namely “V.E.S. Dainik”, through which the persons who came to visit the camp site would get an idea of what all they have done yesterday or day before it.

- **Tree Plantation Program**

The NSS Unit on the occasion of ‘World Environment Day’ on 5th of June 2019 arranged an event of tree plantation in our adopted village Maldunge (Kombaltekdi). 20 volunteers and 2 faculty members had planted 54 Alphonse Mango saplings. The main aim of this event was to encourage awareness about and protection of our environment. 54 trees had been planted in the village and the responsibility of taking care of trees was taken up by the villagers.

- **Yoga Day Program**

(A)University Level Yoga Training Camp

5 days' yoga training camp was conducted by the University of Mumbai in collaboration with K.C. College. One student from our college was a part of that programme.

(B) College Level Yoga Day Program

On International Yoga day (on 21st June 2019), NSS Unit along with Value Lab arranged a Yoga session for the students in our college. The students learnt different Ashanas, yoga practices and meditation. A three days Yoga Camp was also arranged for the college students from 24th June 2019 to 26th June 2019. Mr. Maheshwar (National Level Aerial Yoga Champion 2018-19 and Mallakhamb player) and Mr. Tanmay More (who attended 5 days yoga camp, university level) taught the students the different yoga asanas.

• **Blood Donation Camp**

Two Blood Donation Camps were organized in the College.

(A) On 22nd July 2019, VES College of Arts Science and Commerce, Chembur in association with L.T.M.G. Hospital, Borivali Blood Bank, Rotary Club of Chembur and Think Foundation organized Blood Donation Camp and Thalassemia Check-up Camp. The Motive of this camp was “Your Blood will save someone’s life”. 282 students have done thalassemia check-up and 129 students have donated their blood. 80 volunteers were involved. 129 units of blood were collected. 406 samples were collected for Thalassemia check-up.

(B) On 22nd Feb, 2020, a 2nd Blood Donation Camp was organized in association with Red Cross Blood Bank & Raheja Blood bank. Total 119 donors donated blood. 35 volunteers participated in this drive.

• **Swachhata Pakhwada**

As per the directives of Government of India (Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports), the NSS unit organized “Swachhata Pakhwada” during 1-15 August 2019 for spreading the message of cleanliness not only among the students but also in the surrounding areas. The objective of this project was to spread awareness and evoke sensitivity to virtues of sanitation and cleanliness and help the Government in successfully achieving the initiative of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. Under this project, the volunteers have done the following activities:

- **RRC (Red Ribbon Club) Activities**

As a part of RRC activity, NSS unit organized a Movie Screening (Phir Milenge) on 6th December, 2019. The NSS leaders attended the MDACS Peer Educator Training workshop to spread the awareness regarding AIDS/HIV among the students. They got knowledge regarding sexual health, what is HIV/AIDS, Life Skills, etc. NSS volunteers participated in Area level program- AIDS Awareness Rally arranged by NG Acharya and D.K. Marathe College of Arts, Science & Commerce, Chembur. They also attended a seminar on AIDS Awareness organized by Bunts Sangha Mumbai: Anna Leela College of Commerce & Economics in association with MDACS.

- **Road Safety Awareness measures**

On 5th December, 2019, NSS unit of VES along with Hino motors & Wadala RTO Conducted a workshop on road safety measures for the students to sensitize them about various road accidents, how it occurs frequently in our country and how they can be prevented. Around 144 students were present in that workshop. The volunteers also helped the police on different occasions such as crowd control activity during Ganapati festival and traffic management near Mankhurd bridge on 21st October, the election day.

- **Voter Awareness related Activity**

A seminar titled MAHITI DOOT was arranged by NSS Unit along with NGO 'Anulom' to create awareness about different govt. schemes and policies. N.S.S. Unit had arranged a help desk in college campus to conduct SHAMBAR TAKKE SHAI (voter ID registration camp) along with MONK PRA YOGSHALA. It was held for 3 days i.e. on 22nd, 23rd and 24th of August 2019 near Saraswathi Mandir of our college to help college students above 18yrs make their voter id with ease (through online process). Some volunteers also got training in Mata dan Jagriti Abhiyan at Mulund & Ghatkopar organized by Election Commission office on 15/10/2019 & 18/10/2019. The objective is to spread awareness among the people about the significance of voting.

- **FIT INDIA Campaign in college**

The N.S.S. Unit of VES College of Arts, Science and Commerce organized a live display of inauguration session of FIT INDIA Movement. The main motive of this event was to grab the wonderful opportunity of listening to our honourable Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi speak about the importance of fitness. 127 volunteers attended this event.

The NSS unit celebrated several National days in college campus, namely, Constitutional Day (26th Nov 2019), NSS Day (24th September, 2019), Rastriya Ekta Divas/ Unity Day (31/10/2019), National Peace Day (20/1/2020), National Girls Child day (24/1/2020), etc.

- **NSS Day Celebration**

On 23rd September 2019, NSS unit of VES celebrated the occasion of 50th Anniversary of NSS in the campus. 162 volunteers participated in NSS Day celebration. Rangoli & poster making competition was also organized. 162 NSS volunteers together celebrated this day. In this session, the teachers taught the attendees the golden rules of life which relates to NSS motto 'NOT ME BUT YOU'. It was a successful event where volunteer's performed some cultural activities such as dancing, singing, skit, etc. including social value which encouraged them to be a helpful hand for others.

- **Constitution Day Celebration**

As per the directives of Government of India, Our NSS unit conducted several Constitution related activities.

They celebrated the Constitution Day on 26th Nov,2019 with much fanfare. 250 students were present in the auditorium. 20 volunteers were involved to organize the session. The speaker of the session was Mr. Bhushan Sindhe (Asst. Prof. at VES Law College). The students took the National Pledge. During the special camp, a Quiz competition was organized by a committee member to test the knowledge of students regarding Constitution. NSS unit of VES College conducted the event of Mock Parliament in which 20 volunteers participated as members of ruling, opposition and independent parties. This activity helps them to learn quick decision making, team work, etc. Topic discussed was POCSO Act.

- **Rastriya Ekta Divas/ Unity Day**

On 31/10/2019, to commemorate the birth Anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, NSS unit of VESASC celebrated Unity Day in the college auditorium. The students took the unity pledge. 29 volunteers participated in the event.

- **Celebration of National Youth day**

On 11th January 2020, the volunteers displayed videos (Speech of Guru Gopal Das) on account of youth day in many classes.10 volunteers participated in this activity. Number of beneficiaries were 1500. On 12th January 2020, we celebrated National Youth Day in the college premises. Mrs. Rita Vazirani motivated the students with her positive golden words. 12 volunteers participated in the event.

- **Celebration of National Girl Child Day**

The NSS unit of VES College of Arts, Science & Commerce, Chembur celebrated National Girl Child day on 24th January 2020 to create awareness among the students about the inequalities faced by the girl child and to improve their position in society. The guest speaker, Mrs. Kinjal Pandya, Counseling Psychologist, Ghatkopar, was invited to speak on this occasion. Her session was informative. During her session, she spoke about the actual meaning of 'Feminism' & the people's misconception associated with this. She also mentioned about the wrong attitude of both girls & boys, the topic of Women Empowerment & its importance, etc. As a part of the celebration, Ganesh Bandana, Dance Performance by students, recitation of poems related to girl child & self-defense training were the other highlights of that day. One hundred and four students have participated in that event.

- **Celebration of National Peace day**

On 20th January,2020 NSS unit of VESASC along with NGO "Youth Peace Foundation" celebrated the National Peace day in college auditorium to encourage the students about commitment towards building a culture of Humanity & Peace. Around 52 students were present in that session.

- **Plastic Ban Activity**

Five volunteers and N.S.S. Programme Officer Mrs. Sunita Choudhury attended "Bottle for Change", Training Workshop at Bisleri International Pvt. Ltd. at Andheri. Under Plastic ban activity, a seminar was conducted in our college to make the students aware about re-use and recycle of the plastic. 95 students participated in this event. 9 kgs of plastic has been collected by volunteers & submitted to Bisleri International Pvt. Ltd.

- **Flood Donation Drive**

During flood time in the month of August 2019, NSS unit had arranged a flood donation drive, for helping flood affected people of Sangli, Satara and Kolhapur. They have collected Rice, Dal, Medicines, Sanitary pads, Tea powder, Biscuits, etc & sent those to affected areas. The volunteers also helped Lion's club of Chembur for three days in packaging of the things to be donated for the flood affected people of Kolhapur.

- **Library Set-up Project**

The NSS unit also worked in one of the Innovative Projects called "Library Set-up". On 2nd October 2019 (Gandhi Jayanti), NSS volunteers were able to set up a library in the adopted village Kombaltekd. Around 248 books comprising of text books, story books, novels, drawing books, etc. were kept in the library for the benefit of under-privileged children.

NSS Volunteers participated in various Rallies like Rally on Malaria Awareness, Rally on Swachchata Awareness. Anti-drug Awareness Rally, Diabetics Awareness Rally, HIV/AIDS Awareness Rally, etc.

- **Malaria Awareness Rally**

On 11th July, 2019, A Rally was organised on Malaria Awareness. It was for the people who are underprivileged communities such as those of Mumbai slum (Lal Donger, Kokannagar, etc). 101 volunteers were the part of Rally.

- **Anti-drug rally awareness**

On 1st October, 2019, sixteen volunteers of our College attended Anti Ragging Rally organised by University of Mumbai from Azad Maidan to Gateway of India. The Purpose of this rally was to spread awareness amongst the youth of India and to make them aware about the legal consequences of ragging and misconduct respectively.

- **Area level Peace March**

On 2nd October 2019, 5 volunteers along with NSS PO, Mr. Vikas Ware participated in area level peace march on the occasion of '150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi' by Gurukul College of Commerce, Ghatkopar.

- **Diabetes Awareness Rally**

On 14/11/2019, Lions club International arranged a Diabetes Awareness Rally. 42 volunteers participated in this. The area covered was from Diamond Garden Chembur to Chembur Gymkhana. Sixteen volunteers participated in that rally.

- **Aids awareness Rally**

On 5th December 2019, twelve students participated in the HIV and Aids awareness rally (Area level) organized by N.G. Acharya & D.K. Marathe college of Arts, Science & Commerce, Chembur.

- **Ek Bharat, Shrestha Bharat programme**

Under this scheme, One Marathi and one Odiya Movie were screened in the AV room to update about the diversity as well as unity among the paired States culture, history, tourism etc. On 23rd December 2019, a brief session was conducted by Dr. Preenita and Mrs. Sunita Choudhury on the theme - Cultural diversity of Odisha & Maharashtra. 80 students participated in this session. NSS Unit also conducted a District level activity, "Musafir Chale Odisha", under Ek Bharat, Shrestha Bharat programme on 2nd March 2020. This year, the State of Maharashtra has been paired up with Odisha. The event started with the National Anthem, followed by the lighting of the lamp, a prayer dance in the classical form of Odysseey and a Marathi dance, Shadow Puppetry show called Raavan Chaya and a Sambalpuri folk dance.

- **Bhajan Sandhya**

On 2nd Oct 2019, a Bhajan Sandhya Programme was organised by NSS cell of University of Mumbai at Gate Way of India. This event was attended by 10 volunteers and it was followed by singing different bhajans.

- **Bone Marrow Donor Registration process**

NSS unit of VESASC in association with Bone Marrow Donor Registry India has initiated Bone Marrow registration process in the college campus. On 17th December 2019 the MDRI doctor had visited each classroom for 5 minutes to create awareness among the necessity of Bone Marrow Donor registration. The unit along with Bone Marrow Donor Registry India, had put up a Bone Marrow Donor Registration desk in our college on 18th December 2019, in which, 171 students have registered themselves for Bone Marrow Donation.

- **Republic Day Parade**

India's 71st republic day was celebrated at College ground. 23 volunteers were part of the parade. It was organized by VES Trust. It is a regular feature of NSS unit to perform parade on 26th Jan every year.

- **NSS Activities during Lock down Period**

As a part of social responsibility, the NSS unit had conducted several activities during the lockdown period to spread awareness and fight the Covid-19 pandemic through Social Media. Some students worked with NGOs

for the distribution of food to the needy people. 7 videos & 5 digital posters were made by 22 volunteers. Three Poems regarding the life after lockdown were also put up on the social media profile. Online Inter-Collegiate poster competition was arranged during the lockdown on the topic 'India against Covid-19'. 55 students participated in the poster Competition. With the effort of NSS volunteers, around 450 students downloaded the Arogya Setu app. Apart from this, 28 volunteers have also taken the basic response training from the 'iGot'. The NSS unit of VESASC along with NGO Neeru Foundation of our own NSS alumni Ms. Kajal Waghela, distributed 2500 masks arranged by the College management authorities in many areas like Chembur Camp (Indra Nagar, Old Barrack, MS BLDG), Sion Dharavi, Homeless people-living near Chembur station and P L Lokhande Marg, Road Side People (Vashi road people migrating from Mumbai to other cities).

(ii) Outreach Cell 2019-20

The outreach cell offers social and extension services to people in and around Chembur. This cell functions mainly by the active participation and contribution of our students under the able guidance and supervision of the outreach committee. The purpose of the cell is to sensitize the students regarding the problems and hardships faced by physically, mentally and visually challenged members of our community. Our college is in collaboration with the NGO's and institutions such as NASEOH, Goonj and Umang to carry out this endeavor. An MoU with NASEOH is under process.

The outreach cell undertook several activities during the academic year 2019-20:

- **Conduct of Job Fair of NASEOH**

Our college wholeheartedly supported NASEOH in its endeavours to provide opportunities to people with disabilities to lead a dignified life. NASEOH is an NGO located in Chembur, working for the empowerment of children and adults who are physically challenged and visually impaired. Our college played a major role in conducting their Job Fair held on 10th January 2020 to facilitate employment of persons with disabilities. The huge event which lasted the entire day, saw around 40 hiring corporates and more than 500 job aspirants. 101 students from our college, under the supervision of staff members, volunteered to manage the logistics of the event. They did a stupendous job in coordinating the various functions such as registration, managing the stalls, crowd handling outside the gates, etc.

- **Contribution to NSAEOH**

In the annual donation drive of NASEOH, a sum of Rs. 45,000/- was raised by the students.

• **Clothes Collection Drive for NGO Goonj**

The Outreach Cell organized a clothes collection drive from 2nd - 7th October 2019 on behalf of the NGO Goonj as part of their 'Dil ki suno, kuch karo' (Listen to your heart, Do something) campaign, which urges everyone to give back to the world we live in. This year, Goonj worked across 8 states with people badly hit by monsoon floods. Our students and staff contributed 21 bags of material.

The outreach cell looks forward to more events and strategies to help needy, deserving and physically and mentally challenged children of our society. Over the years we have seen our students not only learn but also enjoy undertaking such programmes which our college is proud to organize for the neighbourhood community.

(iv) Women's Development Cell

- **Two days' workshop on Gender sensitivity**

Gender respect and gender sensitivity is an important value to be inculcated in youth. Keeping this in focus WDC and Value Lab of our college organized two days' workshop (25/6/19 & 26/6/19) on Gender sensitivity. The team decided to avoid a lecture and wanted it to be an experiential process. Instead of presenting abstract concepts, students were exposed to activities and this experience contributed to developing new ways of thinking. This experiential workshop covered Gender stereotype, Gender respect, self-respect & respecting others, managing emotions and engaging in matured behaviours. Students worked through their own process of self-discovery and also learning from others. The workshop was conducted by Dr. Radhika Mohan (Convener, WDC), Department of Psychology.

- **Awareness Programme about functioning of WDC**

It is mandatory for the students to be aware of the WDC and its functions. An Awareness Programme about functioning of WDC was conducted across streams. Members of WDC visited classrooms and addressed students of VES on 15.8.2019 and 16.8.2019.

- **Programme on "Awareness & management of gynecological disorders"**

Ideas of empowerment have changed over years and empowerment of girls needs to include health and hygiene. WDC with Indian Scientist Association had organized a programme on "Awareness & management of gynecological disorders" on 31.8.2019. The speaker was Dr. Santoshi R. Prabhu, Senior Consultant Gynaecologist & Obstetrician, BARC Hospital, Mumbai. The talk gave insights about Gynaecological disorders and the importance of diagnosis and treatment to improve quality-of-life of women and their reproductive health.

- **‘Expressions’**

WDC is committed to educate and empower students, especially girls on their legal rights. Keeping this in mind ‘Expressions’ was conducted in coordination with Majlis, an organisation working for the last 25 years to make justice accessible to women and children. ‘Expression’, - a half day event was organized on 18.2.2020 on the topic "FREEDOM" What's Your Say?". It gave students a platform to express their opinion about the topic which is concerning rights of women. The platform gave lot of room for understanding and reflection.

- **Talk on Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace**

Understanding legal rights makes youth capable of voicing their concerns. The role of ICC in the college, that works closely with WDC, comes in if one feels violated. A talk was organized by WDC and ICC which addressed students and staff on 4th march 2020 with regard to functioning of ICC of our college. The talk focused on awareness and prevention along with procedures to lodge a complaint. Details about drafting of the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 and civil rights were touched upon. The interactive session developed on what sexual harassment in the workplace means in the light of the Sexual Harassment against Women in the Workplace Act of 2013, specifically highlighting the key legal notions of quid pro quo and hostile work environment. Typical examples of what might and what might not constitute sexual harassment in the HEI was included. The speaker stressed the difference between intention and impact. - **Gender Sensitivity workshop:** Value Lab along with WDC had conducted a workshop on Gender Sensitivity, which was conducted across two days (25/6/19 & 26/6/19). - **Skit on Responsibility:** To promote the value Responsibility, on 31st July 2019, the Value lab committee organized a skit on “Responsibility”. This skit was performed by twelve NSS students in the quadrangle of the V.E.S. college of Arts, Science and Commerce between 11:00am-11:30am as well as 1:10pm-1:30pm on the same day.
- **Mind Management and its Control:** A talk was organized under the aegis of Ramakrishna Sarada Mission, entitled “Mind Management and its Control”, on 18th September 2019 by Revered Pravrajika Divyanandaprana Mataji - a monastic member of Sri Sarada Math, Delhi. (140 students and 22 faculty members participated). The objective of this collaborative effort with Ramakrishna Mission was to engage and empower the minds of young students of our college and help improve mental efficiency.

- **Activities conducted during Lock down:** Online learning has come as a panacea during this pandemic and is increasingly seen as a new paradigm in education. Against the backdrop of the Corona pandemic, a multi-pronged strategy was necessary for well-rounded and effective education practice for the capacity building of young minds. In order to take care of student’s overall health during the pandemic Value Lab, VESASC tried to engage students through E - quiz.
