BLOOD Donation DRIVE



Every year we observe 22nd July, the Death Anniversary of our beloved founder member late Shri Hashuji Advani as Nishkam Diwas where NSS Unit of Vivekanand Education Society's College of Arts, Science and Commerce organizes a blood donation camp.

VESASC, in association with Doshi Memorial Charitable Trust's Borivali Blood Bank conducted this event in the college premises. Ms. Alka Surve, coordinator of the blood bank with her medical staff assisted our volunteers and donors for the camp. The camp started from 9 am and ended at 2 pm.

All the donors were screened before donation of blood. They were asked whether they were vaccinated for COVID-19 or had come in to contact with any COVID-19 positive patients. It was ensured that all had face masks and washed their hands before donating blood. Haemoglobin and blood pressure was tested before donation.
