Very Important Notice

For 1st year MMS admissions for the academic year 2016-2017

As per the Maharashtra State Govt. Notification No. 74, 75, 76 & 77 dated March, 2016 and MAHARASHTRA UNAIDED PRIVATE PROFESSIONAL EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (REGULATION OF ADMISSION AND FEES), Act 2015; The Rules for 1st year admission to PG Courses have been changed and new rules have been enacted and laid down for the MMS admission 2016-2017. Therefore aspiring students, parents are hereby informed to please note the above notification and Act carefully to note the Rules and Provisions therein for this year admissions.

Accordingly, The Regional Directorate Technical Education, Mumbai, they have conducted One Day Interactive Workshop on Eligibility and Rules to Regulate the Admissions to Various Professional Technical Courses including MMS and explained the admission procedure 2016-2017 in details in this workshop held in Vivekanand Education Society's Institute of Technology, Collector's Colony, Chembur, Mumbai – 400 074 on dated 16/05/2016.

The Silent Features/Important points for the MMS Admission procedure for the A.Y. 2016-2017 are as below:-

- 1) All admissions including **Minority Quota** admissions shall be done by DTE through their Centralized Admission Process i.e. CAP, which shall be conducted in different rounds. Schedule for these admission Rounds shall be notified by the DTE on their website.
- 2) **Minority Seats Admission** Therefore no admissions form shall be issued from the Institute to Minority Students. Student interested in taking admission under this Minority quota should apply to DTE under the CAP Admission Process only in their prescribed time and date. And while submission of Choice Code of the Institute, student interested in taking admission in VESIM they will have to opt this Institute in their choice code and in priority of choice codes.
- 3) **Management Quota Seats:-** NIL. We do not have this seats (which are available for the management) since we have surrendered this quota to DTE and made it available for the CAP students in the interest of General public. Please note that there will not be any such admissions against this quota.
- 4) **Admission against vacancy/cancellation seats:-** All seats available in this institute i.e. a full Intake of 180 Students have been made available through DTE CAP (a seat break up is as given herein below).

And seats remaining vacant if any, after all the CAP Admission Rounds are over, then shall be made available by DTE in the respective institutes. And these seats shall be filled in by the Institute. Therefore students may apply to this Institute for such the **seats against vacancy**.

Application Forms & Prospectus for these seats shall be available in the Institute after the second round of DTE CAP Admissions and Notice in this regard giving the detail information shall be separately displayed on the Notice Board and also there shall be advertisement for the same in the leading Marathi & English newspapers. You may enquire to our Admission Cell time to time for the availability and submission of these Application forms.

Every student who is interested in applying for the admission against Vacant & Cancellation Seats should be the registered applicant to CAP Admission Process. Only such applicants shall be considered for the Institute Level Admissions against the Cancellation Vacant Seats on the basis of their Merit List No. (Allotted by DTE for CAP admission process). Without this CAP Merit No. student will not be eligible for the Vacancy Rounds Seats at Institute Level Admissions.

- 5) **Tentative dates for the admissions against the Cancellation & Vacant Seats:-** Tentative dates shall be between 1st August to 14th August 2016. Exact date shall be declare later on.

In very short time DTE will be notifying the **Admission Information Broucher 2016-2017** on their website, which shall contain all the Information regarding the Basic Qualification, Eligibility Criteria including CET details and the registration process of **CET & Other Common Entrance Tests students** for the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) conducted by Directorate of Technical Education.

Therefore all the interested students and are hereby requested to please visit DTE website and note the necessary information and follow the dates scrupulous.

Regarding Fees for this academic year 2016-2017

The Fee/Interim Fee information is awaited from Fee Regulatory Authority of Maharashtra State. We will display this information including category wise fees as soon as it is announced by the above authority.

However last year fee for the academic year 2015-2016 was Rs. 1, 85,000/-. Therefore the Interim Fees for this academic year shall be around/approximate to **Rs. 1, 85,000/-**.

Cutoff date of the admission

This shall be notified by The Directorate Technical Education, Mumbai in their PG Admission Information Brochure 2016-2017.

Refund Rules

The rules for refund of fees on the cancellation of admission also shall be notified by DTE in their Admission Information Brochure (PG Courses) 2016-2017. This Admission Brochure shall be made available by DTE on their website only. And therefore hard copies shall not be made available in DTE office. Parents & Students are advised to note the important provisions and Admission Rules, Refund Rules, Cutoff Date & other important dates very carefully from their website.

- 1) The above mentioned information and rules shall be **subject to time to time changes, if any, by the concerned state Govt. Authorities and DTE.**
